Testimony

At the execution of the annexed Commission, issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County and to us directed empowering us to examine Evidence in the Cause depending in the said Court, between Godfrey Koorly Trustee of Nancy Taylor as William H. Lealey Joseph C. Miller and others, vs. Francis Brangle and John E. R. Wood, Commissioners there in named, did on the 13th day of November A.D. 1868, at our office in Frederick City Maryland, then and there proceed to take testimony as follows: -

Godfrey Koorly a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioners by the Complainant and herewith returned, deposes and says: -

To the 1st Int: - That he knows all the parties to this suit, except Patrick Le Rowland and George L. Michael, and John Anderson & Co, James H. Cox Jr. and Brothers, and has known them for a number of years. -

To the 2nd Int: - That he knows the signature of William H. Lealey because he saw him sign it. -

There being no other witnesses present to be examined, and the Complainant requiring no further time for the prosecution of their evidence, the Commissioners closed the said Commission, and herewith returned the same under their hands and seals on this 13th day of November A.D. 1868 -
