Williamson married to Julia Keamp, a daughter, Manzella married to Abram Huntress, a son, James J. Williamson married to Emma Leonty, a daughter Josephine S. Williamson, a daughter Maria Melissa C. Williamson, a son Warren G. A. Williamson, a daughter Selara A. Williamson, a son William R. Williamson, a daughter, Laura O. Williamson, a daughter Ada O.
