Interrogatories Elizabeth Cox vs Jacob Renner et al No. 3266 Equity In the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity

Interrogatories to be propounded to Elias Delander and Henry Hoover, witnesses on the part of the Complainant

1st Int: Do you know the parties to this suit? If so, state their names and where they reside, and who among them are under 21 years of age, and who are over twenty and?

2nd Int: Is Andrew Cox dead? If so, when did he die, and how many children did he leave, and where do they live, and what is their names, ages, and who is his widow, where does she reside, and what is her age?

3rd Int: Do you know the Real Estate left by said Andrew Cox, if so, look at Exhibit A, and state whether the land therein described, is the land left by said Andrew Cox, at his death?

4th Int: Look at Exhibit B, and state whether that is the Mortgage on said land, that was executed by said Andrew Cox and Henry Hoover and state whether said Mortgage has been paid.

5th Int: Look at Exhibits Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4. State whether the signatures to said notes are in the hand writing of Andrew Cox and Henry Hoover, and if so, whether they have been paid?

6th Int: State whether said land is susceptible of partition or division among all the parties interested, with advantage to them all, and if you think not, give your reasons for so thinking.

7th Int: Would it be to the interest and advantage of all the parties interested, that said land should be sold, and the proceeds arising therefrom, be distributed among the said parties in proportion of their respective interests; If so give your reasons therefor.
