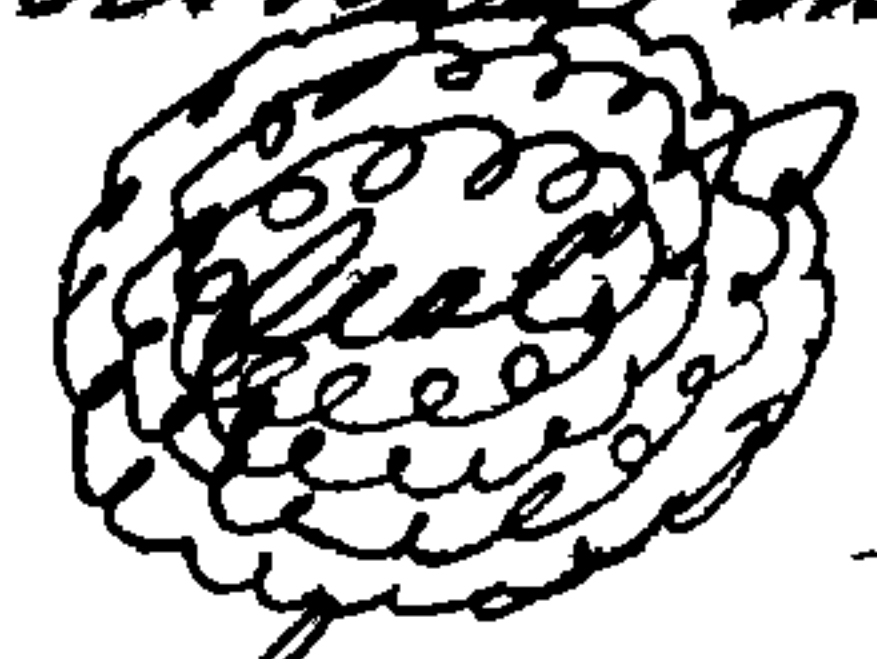


Exhibit D

In the name of God, Amen! Know all men by these presents that I Henry Willhite of Frederick County and State of Maryland being in ill health, but of sound and disposing mind and Memory, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made, and as to my worldly Estate and all the property real, personal or mixed, which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease, I devise bequeath and dispose thereof in the manner following, to wit: First my Will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall by my daughter Levey Ann Willhite hereinafter named, be paid as soon after my decease as shall be found convenient.

Item, I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Levey Ann Willhite all my House and land which I now hold and occupy and furniture and all my property at the time of my decease it lying in Croxetown District Frederick County State of Maryland, to hold for her own use and purposes, so long as she shall live, and after her death and expenses are paid, the property shall be sold by my Executors hereinafter mentioned of the proceeds I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Haining over One dollar.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Susan Hewit One Dollar.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Catharine Harris the one half of the remaining money of my Estate.
