

stone now planted and marked N^o 23 S 42° 45' 30" W 75 1/2 ft. to a stone now planted and marked N^o 24 standing in a Meadow S 68° E 17 1/4 ft. ending in the public road leading past the Woodville School House to Fredericktown, and at the end of one perch on a line drawn S 84° W from a stone now planted and marked N^o 24 standing by the side of said public road - it being the beginning of the deed from John Gittinger to John Miller for 3 1/4 acres, part of the Resurvey on Haover's Fancy" dated the 2nd day of February 1819, one of the present Originals - then with the given line of said deed, and with the Centre of said public road S 40° E 21 3/4 ft. to a stone now planted and marked N^o 35, then with the East side of a lane, it being the divisional line between the said John Miller and the widow of the late Daniel Hildebrand S 36 1/4° W 113 1/2 ft. to a stone now planted and marked N^o 36 at the end of the 1 1/4 line of the deed from Daniel and George Gittinger to John Miller for 58 acres, part of the Resurvey on Haover's Fancy" dated the 30th day of May 1835 one of the present originals, and at the end of the end of the 2nd line of Lot N^o 8, one of the divisions of said Resurvey on Haover's Fancy" then with the 2nd line of said deed by 1 1/4 allowance for variation S 34 3/4° E 104 1/2 ft. to a stone now planted and marked N^o 37 standing at the end of the 5th and last line of the deed from John Gittinger to John Miller for 10 acres, parts of Lots N^o 6, 7, & 8 divisions of "The Resurvey on Haover's Fancy" dated the 4th day of December 1819 one of the present originals, then with the Closing line of said deed N 48 1/4° E 90 1/4 ft. to intersect the third line of the afore-said tract called "Hill in the Middle", it being in the Centre of the afore-said public road, at the end of one perch on a line drawn N 48 1/4° E from a stone now planted and marked N^o 38, standing on the west margin of said public Road, then by a straight line to the place of beginning, Containing 357²/₃ 3²/₃ 33 ft. of land Resurveyed this 1st day of November A.D. 1847, and called "John Miller's Resurvey"
