

degrees West twenty seven and a half perches to a stone, thence with the third line thereof reversed North One degree, West twenty four perches to stone at fence, and the West edge of said road; thence by dividing lines now made, North fifty degrees East one and three fourths perches, thence North thirty four and a half degrees, West three perches to Centre of watering place; thence North fifty degrees East one perch, thence South thirty four and a half degrees East three perches; thence North fifty degrees, East eleven and three fourths perches to a stone at the end of the sixth line in the deed aforesaid from Abraham Layler and wife to J. Stoussifer, and with sixth line reversed, South twenty seven degrees East sixty three and three fourths perches thence to a stone, to the end of the third line in the deed from Jared Stoussifer and wife to George Spouty bearing date the 27th of June 1857 and with the closing line thereof and on South Eighty four and three fourths degrees West thirty five and a fourth perches to the beginning, and containing eight and a half acres and thirty four square perches of land more or less: all said land thus conveyed in fee simple.

At the request of George Spouty the following Deed was Recorded May 15th 1860

This Deed made this twenty fourth day of April Anno Domini One thousand Eight hundred and sixty, by Solomon Strasher, and Nancy his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and sixty one dollars, and ninety seven and a half cents Current money, the said Solomon Strasher and Nancy his wife, do grant unto George Spouty of said County and State, the following described part of a tract of land called "The Journey on Hunting Lot" lying and being with County and State aforesaid. Beginning at a stone at the end of the 5th line in the deed from Jacob Rider and wife to said Strasher, bearing date the 5th day of April 1859, and running thence with the lines thereof, North sixty and a half degrees East nine perches; North seventy nine degrees East fourteen and one fourth perches perches to a planted stone, thence North forty seven degrees East sixteen perches; thence North thirty eight and a half degrees East nine and a half perches outside of fence; thence by dividing lines now made, South thirty three and a fourth degrees East nineteen
