

George Pfoutz died seized and possessed, and the Exhibits 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, contain a correct description of said lands.

Error loci

To the 3rd Sub: That he was acquainted with George Pfoutz, who was a resident of Frederick County. He is dead, died in January, A.D. 1868 in Frederick County.

To the 5th Sub: That the said George Pfoutz left Children - Hannah, Annie E. Elizabeth, Sarah E. Adults, Martha and Lda. infants. - Hannah, married John W. Diehl, Elizabeth married William H. Keener, Sarah married Daniel R. Saylor. All of them live in Frederick County, except Daniel R. Saylor and wife who live in Carroll County.

To the 6th Sub: That he is acquainted with the lands whereof the said George Pfoutz died seized and possessed. They cannot be divided without loss and injury to all the parties interested, does not believe said lands can be equally divided. - It would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties interested, that the said lands be sold, and the proceeds divided among those interested.

Error loci

To the 4th Sub: That the said George Pfoutz was married at the time of his death, and left a widow - Catharine Pfoutz, who resides in Frederick County.

Peter Smith, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainants being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioners by the Complainants, deposes and says.

To the 1st Sub: That he is acquainted with the parties to this Decree, has known them a number of years.

To the 2nd Sub: That he lived with Pfoutz for a long time, and believes that the Exhibits 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, contain correct descriptions of his lands.

To the 3rd Sub: That he was acquainted with said George Pfoutz, a citizen of Frederick County. He is dead, died in January A.D. 1868.

To the 4th Sub: That said George Pfoutz left a widow Catharine Pfoutz who now resides in Frederick County.

To the 5th Sub: That the said George Pfoutz had six Children, Hannah, Annie E. Elizabeth, Sarah E. Adults, Martha and Lda. infants. - Hannah married John W. Diehl, Elizabeth married William H. Keener, Sarah married Daniel R. Saylor. All live in Frederick County, except Daniel R. Saylor and his wife who reside in Carroll County.

To the 6th Sub: That he is acquainted with the lands whereof the said George Pfoutz died seized and possessed. - They cannot be divided without loss or injury to all the parties interested. - Thinks it would be better to sell the lands, as it would not suit to divide them.

There being no other witnesses present to be examined, and the Complainants requiring no further time for the prosecution of their evidences, the Commissioners closed the said Commission, and herewith returned the same under their hands and seals, on this day of September Eighteen Hundred and Eighty Eight.
