This Mortgage made this twelfth day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty two, by me Jacob Markell of Frederick County and State of Maryland, witnesseth that whereas I Jacob Markell and George Markell by our joint and several promissory note for the sum of Eight thousand dollars, dated on the twelfth day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty two (in which said note the said George Markell is more surely for said Jacob Markell) promised six months after the date thereof to pay to John H. Williams Cashier or order, Eight thousand dollars for value received negotiable and payable at the Frederick County Bank, and whereas the said John H. Williams Cashier endorsed and delivered the said note to the President and Directors of the Frederick County Bank, who are now Holders of the same, and whereas the said note was discounted by the said Frederick County Bank for the sole use and accommodation of Jacob Markell the principal in said note, Now to secure the payment of said sum of money in said note specified at maturity, and when payment thereof shall be demanded by the said Bank, or if hereafter the said note be renewed from time to time to pay the note or notes in renewal thereof at maturity when payment thereof shall be demanded by said Bank - I the said
