Deed was recorded January 21st 1864

This Deed made this twenty fifth day of December in the year Eighteen hun-
-dred and sixty three by Harry Leuckett Attorney in fact for Basil Leuckett
of the one part, and Benjamin Todd of the other part, all of Frederick County
in the State of Maryland & Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of
Eighty dollars, the said Harry Leuckett Attorney as aforesaid, doth grant
unto the said Benjamin Todd in fee simple all that piece or parcel of a
tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid called
"Hobbs' Purchase", and contained within the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning for the same at the end of 17th perches on the 15th line of the late Harry
W. Elfrink's part of said land called "Hobbs Purchase", it being at the East cor-
-ner of the main road, then with said 15th line, South 55 degrees East 14 perches
South 67¹/₂ degrees East 5³/₄ perches, North 48¹/₂ degrees - 3¹/₄ perches, North
31¹/₄ West 16 perches, North 31¹/₂ degrees West 18¹/₂ perches to the East side of the main
road, and with said road, South 45¹/₂ degrees West 17¹/₂ perches, South 31¹/₂
degrees West 29¹/₂ perches, South 23 degrees West 5¹/₂ perches to the Beginning
containing Eight and one quarter acres and two and three quarters square perches
of land, and being the same land which was conveyed to the said Basil Leuckett
by Samuel Salbott and Catharine Salbott his wife by deed dated the 20th day of
October 1857, and recorded amongst the Land Records of Frederick County a Liber
C.S. No. 9 Folio 636 &c and also the same property contained in the power of Attorney
from the said Basil Leuckett made and executed on the 11th day of October
A. D. 1859 and duly recorded amongst the Land Records of Frederick
