To the Honorable John C. Smith Judge of the Circuit Court for Carroll County, as a Court of Equity.

The Report of John LeDovall Trustee appointed by the Decree in this cause to make sale of Certain Real Estate therein mentioned, shows that after giving bond with security for the faithful discharge of his trust, as required by said decree, and giving notice of the time, place, manner and terms of sale by advertisement in the American Sentinel, a newspaper printed in Washington Carroll County, also in the Frederick Examiner a newspaper printed in the City of Frederick for more than three successive weeks before the day of sale, and by hand bills extensively circulated through Carroll and Frederick Counties also through Howard and Montgomery Counties, he did pursuant to said notice attend upon the land and premises aforesaid on Thursday the twenty ninth day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six at 2 O'clock P. M. and then and there proceeded to offer the said Real Estate for sale, as follows, to wit - In the first place your Trustee offered at Public Sale to the highest bidder the farm and premises mentioned in the proceedings in this case, but after using every effort was unable to sell the same for more than the sum of Four thousand dollars, which was the highest amount bid for the same which your Trustee considering an inadequate price, refused to sell the same.

Your Trustee further Reports that he has since been enabled to sell the said farm for the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, that being the highest and best price your Trustee could procure for the same at private Sale, which Sale was made on the first day of May Eighteen hundred and sixty six, to Benjamin Todd, upon the terms prescribed by the Decree passed in this cause, and that he has received in cash one third of the purchase money for the same, and has taken the bonds of the purchaser for the deferred payments, for one and two years with G. S. Stamm and Henry Danner his sureties for the punctual payment of said instalments with interest from the day of sale
