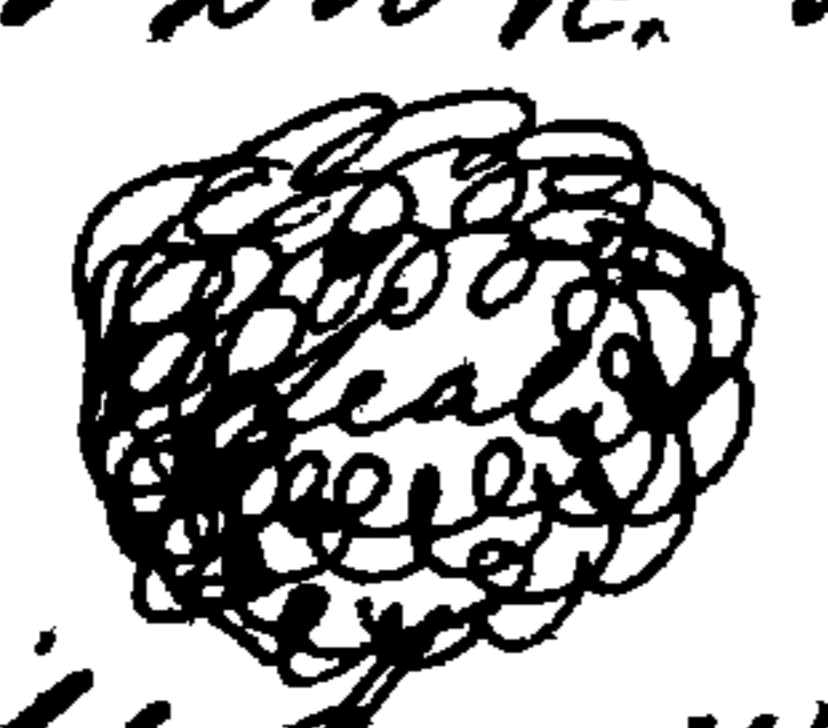

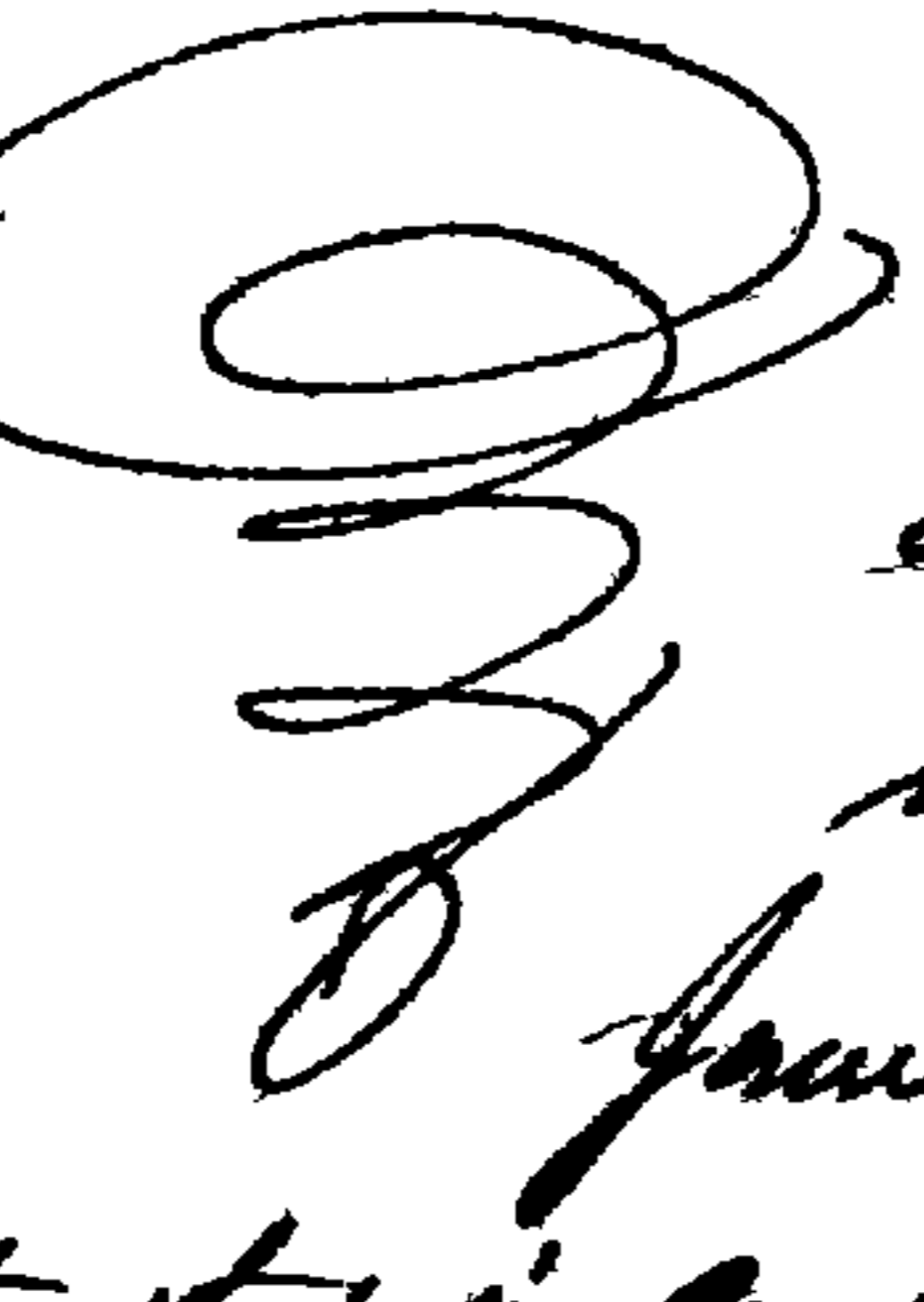

This Deed

This Deed made this first day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty by Levin Hood and Caroline Hood his wife, James Hood and Kitty Hood of Howard County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of the Hundred and twenty five dollars, the said Levin Hood and Caroline his wife, James Hood and Kitty Hood, do grant unto Benjamin Hood his heirs and assigns in fee simple, all the Estate, right, title, claim and interest of them the said Levin Hood and Caroline his wife and James Hood and Kitty Hood, and each and every of them, of in and to all those pieces or parcels of land lying in Howard County, in the State aforesaid, which were conveyed to them, the said Levin Hood, James Hood and Kitty Hood and Samuel T. Hood and Joshua Todd, Junior, as tenants in common, by Benjamin Todd and wife, and John Wood and wife by deed dated the twenty seventh day of September Eighteen hundred and forty one, and recorded in Liber N. D. & No. 8 folio 519 to one of the Land Records Books of Howard County as by reference thereto will appear, the said Estate and interest hereby conveyed being three fifths of the whole amount of the land and premises which were conveyed or intended to be conveyed to the said Levin Hood, James Hood, Kitty Hood, Samuel T. Hood and Joshua Todd, Junior by the deed hereinbefore mentioned, do have and to hold the lands and premises hereby granted, unto the said Benjamin Hood his heirs and assigns forever ~ And the said Levin Hood, James Hood and Kitty Hood, Covenant that they will warrant specially the property hereby conveyed. ~ Witness our hands and seals. ~

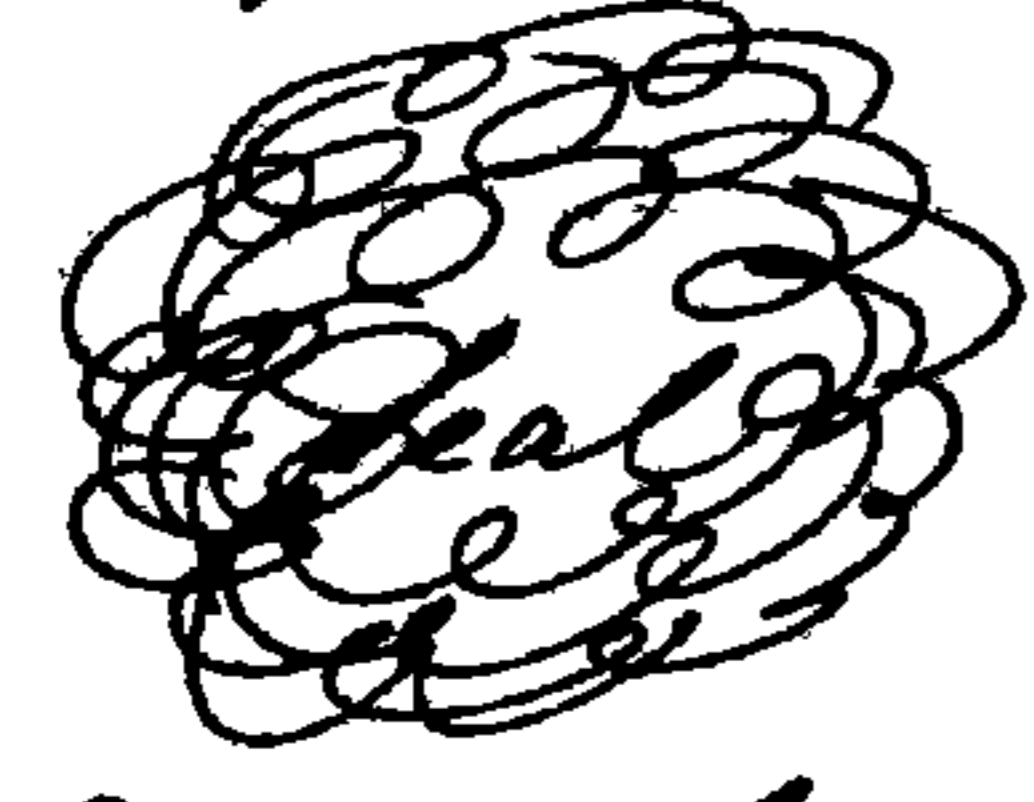
