This Deed made this thirteenth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty five by Lewis Kenawford of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Trustee, Witnesseth, whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity dated on the twenty ninth day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty four, and passed in the case of Charles Miller and others vs. Eve B Miller and others being No. 3117 on the Equity docket of the said Court I Lewis Kenawford was appointed Trustee to sell the land decreed to be sold, and have sold the hereinafter described part thereof to Charles Miller of the County and State aforesaid, at and for the sum of three thousand three hundred and forty six dollars and fifty seven and one third cents, who has fully paid the purchase money therefor. Now therefore in consideration of the premises, I Lewis Kenawford Trustee as aforesaid do hereby grant unto the said Charles Miller all the right and title of all the parties to the aforesaid cause in and to the following described piece or parcel of land, situate lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland being part of a tract of land called "Mary's Delight" as surveyed and laid off in the surveyors plat marked "No. 1" and filed with the Trustee's Report of Sales, in said Equity case.
