

fourth degree East twenty perches, South forty four and three fourths degrees West Eight perches to a stone planted at the end of the 14th line of the aforesaid tract of land called "Marys Delight" and with it, the following courses and distances correcting the same, South forty seven and three fourths degrees East forty three perches, North thirty eight and one fourth degrees East thirty six perches, South forty four and three fourths degrees East forty nine and nine tenths perches North thirty six and one fourth degrees East thirty nine and four tenths perches to a stone, North Eighty degrees East sixty perches North twenty seven and one fourth degrees East twenty six perches, South forty four and three fourths degrees East forty perches, North seventy four and one fourth degrees East sixteen perches to the beginning of the deed from John Miller to Frederick Miller dated February 20th 1849 and with said deed reversed correcting the same North fifteen degrees East sixty six perches North four degrees East fifty perches to the end of the 5th line expressed in said deed, thence with the dividing lines now made between this and the 44¹/₂ Acre parcel the following courses and distances, South thirty seven degrees West forty six and seven tenths perches South fifty seven and a half degrees West thirty five and four tenths perches, North thirty nine and one half degrees West twenty nine and six tenths perches South sixty five degrees West fourteen perches North seventy six and one half degrees West seven and five tenths perches North Eighty eight and three fourths degrees West nine and six tenths perches North forty three and one half degrees West twenty three and five tenths perches to the end of 89th perches on the 21st line expressed in said deed from Amos Bigham to John Miller and with said line, correcting the same, North Eighty six and a half degrees West thirty and six tenths perches, North eighty one and three fourths degrees West forty perches to a stone South sixty nine and one fourth degrees West fourteen and thirty hundredths perches to a stone South thirty and a half degrees East thirty three and eighty hundredths to the place of Beginning, containing one hundred and twenty nine and a half acres more or less.

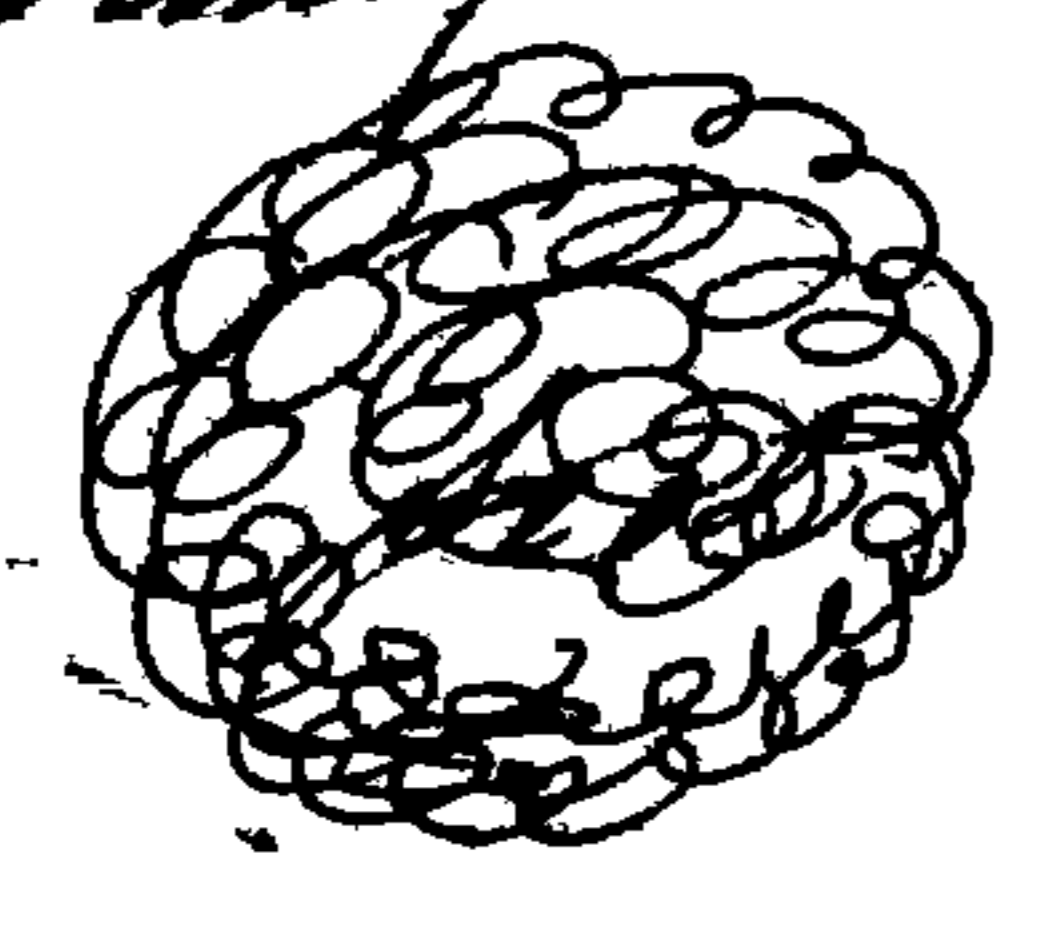
