Your complainants further charges that said Ellen Baker at the time of her death was a widow - and that she died as aforesaid in the month of October in the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty seven leaving the following Children her heirs at law, viz.

- 1st Nathan L Baker, a son, who married Julia Ann Warfield ~
- 2nd William H Baker a son, who married Harfield ~
- 3rd Mary E - a daughter who married your complainant Daniel M Snyder.
- 4th Theodore Harrison Baker, a son, who married Fannina Mealy ~
- 5th Sarah A. G. - a daughter, who married your complainant John H Fogle ~
- 6th Samuel Jacob Baker a son who married Mary Warfield ~
- 7th Basil Baker -
- 8th John Baker -
- 9th Ruben Sidwell Baker -
- 10th Martha E Baker - All of whom reside in Frederick County State of Maryland, and all of whom are of full age, except Ruben Sidwell Baker and Martha E Baker, who are infants under the age of twenty one years. ~

Your complainants further charge, that the Real Estate mentioned aforesaid, cannot be divided amongst the parties interested without loss and injury, and that it would be to the interest and advantage of all parties concerned, that the said real estate in the proceedings mentioned, be sold under a decree to be passed by your Honorable Court, and the proceeds of sale divided amongst those interested ~

It is the end therefore that the Defendants hereinafter named may answer the matters and things herein before stated and charged as fully and as particularly as if herein again repeated, and that they were thereunto specially interrogated, and that the real estate in the proceeding mentioned may be sold under and by virtue of a decree of your Honorable Court, and the proceeds of said sale be divided amongst those interested, and that your complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of their case may require. ~

May it please your Honors to grant unto your complainants the writ of Subpoena against the said Nathan L Baker and Julia Ann Baker his wife, William H Baker and Baker his wife, Theodore Harrison Baker, and Fannina Baker his wife, Samuel Jacob Baker and Mary Baker his wife, Basil Baker, John Baker, Ruben ^{Sidwell} Baker, and Martha E Baker of Frederick County State of Maryland, Commanding them to appear on this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises, and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed thereon, and as in duty bound, &c. ~
