Frederick Nov. 29th 1850 ~

I promise to pay to Ezra Doub, Surviving Executor of Valentine Doub death and Trustee of his Widow Esther Doub, the sum of Two thousand two hundred and Ten Dollars \$ 2210⁰⁰ on the Twelfth day of November A.D. 1857.

And the further sum of three thousand seven hundred and ninety dollars \$ 3790⁰⁰ on the Twelfth day of November A.D. 1852, the interest on each of these sums to commence from the first day of April next, and to be payable semi-annually on the first days of October and April thereafter ~

This Mortgage made this second day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty two by us Joshua S. Gibson and Susan Gibson his wife of Jefferson County State of Virginia, Witnesseth, that whereas I the said Joshua S. Gibson, by my sealed note bearing even date with these presents payable to Nancy Taylor one year after date with interest from date, the interest payable annually, am indebted to the said Nancy Taylor in the sum of Thirty six hundred & sixty six dollars and sixty six 2/3 cents and to secure the payment of the sum of money in said single bill recited when the same becomes due and payable, and to secure the payment of the interest thereon annually, we the said Joshua S. Gibson and Susan Gibson his wife do grant in fee simple to the said Nancy Taylor all the following pieces or parcels ^{and lots} of land, situate in Frederick County and State of Maryland as follows, all those parts of a tract of land known as "Rocky Spring" containing Two hundred and twenty acres and three fourths acres of land
