Special Interrogatories to be proposed to John Reifmeider and Godfrey Kooty witnesses to be produced and sworn on the oath of Complainant.

To John Reifmeider

1st Int: Are you or not, Agent for Ezra Doub Surviving Executor of the last Will of Valentine Doub?

2^d Int: You say you are Agent, Look at Exhibit now shown you, and the note now produced by you. Do you or do you not know the handwriting of the late Dr. William Waters? If yes, is the note now produced by you, signed by said William Waters, and is said note of which Exhibit in Bill is a true copy?

3rd Int: The Exhibit now shown you describes, two notes as intended to be secured by said Mortgage. Has any one of said notes been paid, and which of them, and by whom? Is the other note now produced by you, still owing and due? Has any part thereof principal or interest been paid, if yes, when and how much, and what amount of principal is due, and from what time is the interest payable? State all your knowledge herein.

Special Interrogatories to be proposed to Godfrey Kooty

1st Int: Were you, or were you not the agent of Mrs. Nancy Taylor deceased, if you look at Exhibit No. Now shown you. Did you as such Agent loan the sum of money therein named, to Joshua G. Gibson?

2^d Int: Did or did not Mrs. Nancy Taylor, or you as her agent assign said Mortgage to any person? If so, to whom, and who is now the holder of the note intended to be secured thereby.

3rd Int: Do you know the lands of which Dr. William Waters died seized and possessed? If yes, look at Exhibits B & C now shown you, do such Exhibits describe said Lands? State fully all your knowledge herein.

4th Int: Do you or do you not know, the children of Dr. W. Waters living at his death? If married to whom? If dead, The names of them or their children and places of residence? State fully all your knowledge herein.

5th Int: Are the Lands of which Dr. W. Waters died seized and possessed, referred to and described in your answer to the previous interrogatory susceptible of division without loss or injury to the parties interested? If not state your reasons.
