

Shub to David Homes dated February, 11th 1825, and running thence South sixty two degrees fifty minutes East five and a half perches to the beginning of a Deed from John W. Creager to David Homes dated March 31st 1838 and running thence with said deed South sixty two degrees fifty minutes East twenty six perches to a stone, North twenty five and three quarter degrees, East six and three quarter perches to a stone, South sixty three and one eighth degrees East one hundred and sixty three and one half perches to the public road, then with said road North twenty four degrees East forty one and three quarter perches to a stone North sixty three and one eighth degrees West one hundred and eighty eight perches to a stone, then leaving the lines of said deed and running North sixty three and one eighth degrees West five perches to a stone, then South twenty six and one half degrees West forty eight and one quarter perches to the beginning, containing fifty one acres three rods and fifteen perches of land including a road from the public road to the Home Farm now occupied by the said Josiah Jones and Mary E Jones his wife, which road as it now is located is reserved for the use of said farm as long as it suits the convenience of the said John W. Creager, should the said road be changed to the other side of the said land mentioned herein, the division fence between the said John W. Creager and the Home Farm now occupied by said Josiah Jones and Mary E Jones his wife to be removed back upon the fifty acres and three rods of land intended to be conveyed by this deed until the surplus of land exceeding the fifty acres to be returned to the owner of said Home place, it being the intent to reserve said road for the use of the Home place, and to convey to said John W. Creager fifty acres and three rods, exclusive of said road, together with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining. To Have and to hold the piece or parcel of land and premises above described with their appurtenances unto the said John W. Creager his heirs and assigns forever, reserving the road running from the public road to the said Home Farm, as now located for the use of the said Home Farm, and the owners thereof, or if changed by John W. Creager reserving the road as changed or altered.
