

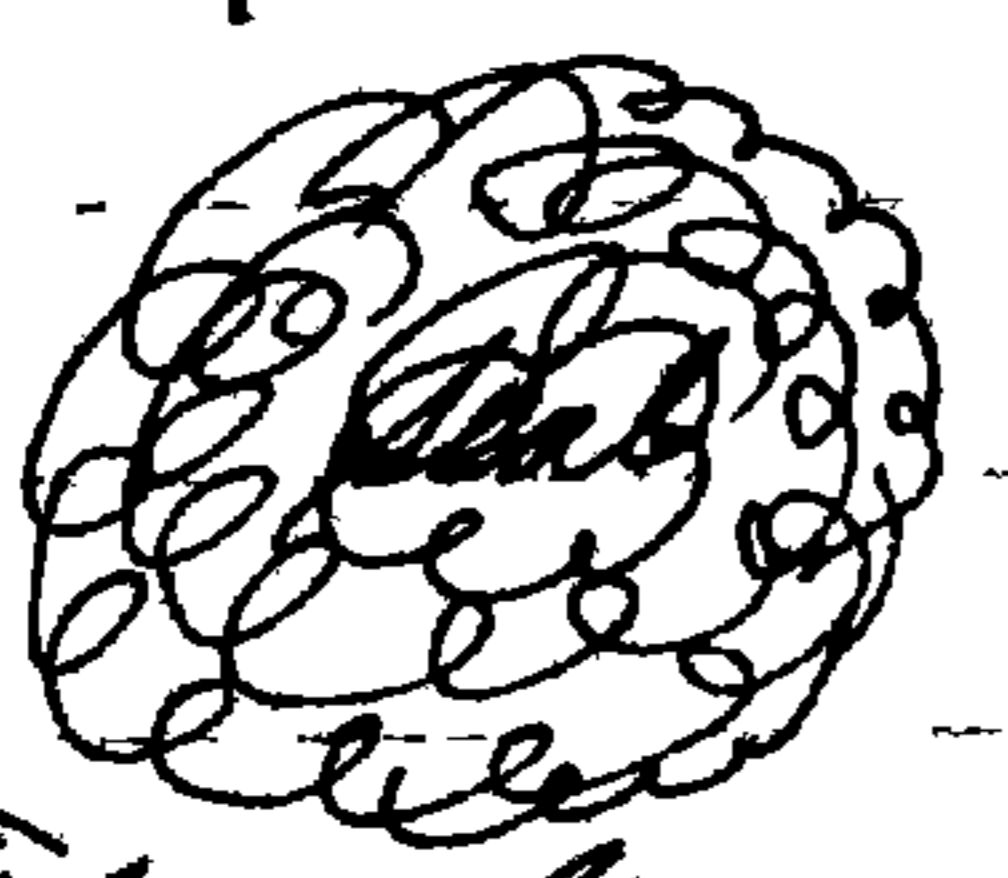

This Deed, made this fourth day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty four by us John William Leveager, and Mary Ann his wife, Witnesseth, that in consideration of One hundred and fifty dollars, we the said John William and Mary Ann Leveager do grant to Hugh McAllister the following described parcel of land lying in Hoodsborough District Frederick County Maryland being part of the tract of land originally called "Moores Manor" and embraced within the following lines to wit: Beginning at a stone standing at the end of the second line of a tract of land called "Self Defence" and running thence with said tract, South 27 degrees West 67 1/2 perches to a stone, North 63 degrees West 32 1/4 perches to the land conveyed by William J. Ross Trustee to said McAllister, thence with said land North 27 degrees East 47 1/2 perches, South 63 degrees East 6 perches to intersect the fourth line of a deed from William Grimes to me the said John William Leveager, and running thence with said line South 27 degrees West 41 perches to the end of 26 perches on a line drawn North 63 degrees West from the beginning, thence with said line reversed, South 63 degrees East 26 perches to the beginning containing two and three fourths acres more or less.
