Be it known, that you are appointed Commissioners, to examine evidences in a
cause depending in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, between
Abraham Fineman Complainant, and Susan Young Admt. of Samuel Young, and
others Defendants. You are therefore required, having first taken the Oaths here-
