 Your Complainant in this his Amended Bill further charges, that a certain William Richardson, some years since sold to a certain Charles Leach of Frederick County, a piece or portion of land situate in Buckeystown District Frederick County Maryland - that said Charles Leach was unable to comply with the terms of sale, and sold the same tract of land to the said Grafton Duvall - That said Duvall in his lifetime took possession of said land, and paid to the said Richardson the balance of the purchase money therefor, and died before receiving a deed for the same - And your Complainant charges that the said Grafton Duvall died seized and possessed of the said land purchased as aforesaid, and that said land in conjunction with the lands aforementioned descended to the said children of the said Duvall as his heirs at law.

And your Complainant in this his Amended Bill reiterates all the charges in said Original Bill, as to said personal estate of said Grafton Duvall being insufficient to pay his debts - And that the real estate of said Grafton Duvall, or as much thereof as may be necessary ought to be sold for the payment of his debts. ~

To the end therefore that the Defendants may answer the Original as well as the Amended Bill of Complaint, the same as if the matters and things therein charged were herein again repeated, and they were thereunto specially interrogated, and that the real estate in the proceedings mentioned, or as much thereof as may be necessary, may be sold for the payment of the Claims of your Complainant, and of all other Creditors of said Grafton Duvall, who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, and that your Complainant may have all such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of this case may require, And may it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant the writ of Subpoena, against the said Columbus Duvall Samuel Duvall, Edwin Duvall, Arthur Delashmutt and Benjamin H. Duvall Executors of the last Will and Testament of Grafton Duvall Daniel Baker, and Baker his wife, Benjamin A. Cunningham and Cunningham his wife, Arthur Delashmutt and Delashmutt his wife, William Richardson and Elizabeth Richardson his wife, and Charles Leach of Frederick County State of Maryland commanding them to appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named, to answer the Original as well as the Amended Bill of Complaint, and to abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein, and as in duty bound &c. ~
