Humbly Complaining, Showeth unto your Honors, Your Orators Juiseo Marlow and Draco, of Sangamon County Illinois, Sarah A. Clapham of Loudoun County West Virginia, Thomas J. Marlow of Calloway County, Missouri, Robert E. Marlow, also of said last named County and Eliza Marlow of Montgomery Missouri, that a certain Thomas J. Marlow late of Frederick County aforesaid was during his lifetime seized and possessed in fee simple of certain real estate, lying and being situate in said last mentioned County and which is more particularly described in a certain deed of conveyance from Robert E. Dorsey, Trustee, to the said Thomas J. Marlow dated September 19<sup>th</sup> 1837 and recorded in Liber St. S. No 5 folio 383 one of the Land Records of said County, a certified Copy whereof is herewith filed and marked Exhibit "A" which together with all other Exhibits, Your Orators pray may be taken as part of this their Bill of Complaint. ~

Marlow departed this life sometime in the year 18-- intestate, leaving him surviving his widow Mary Marlow, and the following Children and Grand Children, his heirs at Law, to whom said real Estate descended as tenants in common, to wit: Your Orators, Juiseo Marlow, Draco Marlow, Sarah A. Clapham wife of Samuel Clapham, Thomas J. Marlow Robert E. Marlow, John S. Marlow, and Parmenio Marlow, Margaret E. Duderow Mary O. Marlow, Francis L. Marlow; That John S. Marlow is dead, that he left him surviving his widow Eliza Marlow and the following Children to wit: William H. Marlow, Thomas M. Marlow Clarence Marlow, Edward E. Marlow, James D. Marlow Mary E. Marlow and Johnette S. Marlow, who are all infants under the age of twenty one years, and reside in Montgomery County, in the State of Missouri. ~
