Interrogatories to be propounded to the witnesses produced upon the part of the Complainants in No 3381 Equity ~

1st Sub. ~ Do you know the parties Complainant and Defendant in this suit? If yes, how long have you known them?

2nd Sub. ~ State if you know which of them are Adults and which of them infants under the age of twenty one years. ~

3rd Sub. Did you know Thomas J. Marlow mentioned in Bill of Complaint? If yes, is he living or dead?

4th Sub. ~ Do you know the real estate whereof said Thomas J. Marlow died seized and possessed?

5th Sub. ~ State whether the same is capable of an advantageous division amongst all the parties to this suit? or whether it would be to the interest and advantage of all parties Adults and infants, that the same should be sold and the proceeds divided amongst the parties entitled. ~

6th Sub. Give the reasons for your opinion? ~

7th Sub. State the age of Mary Marlow mentioned in Bill of Complaint. ~

Interrogatories

At the Execution of the Annexed Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and to us directed, empowering us to examine witnesses in the Cause depending in said Court, between Daiso Marlow, Draso Marlow and others vs Parmenio Marlow, Margaret E. Darbonow and others, we Francis Brengle and J. E. R. Wood, Commissioners therein named, did on the 22nd day of September A.D. 1869 at our office in Frederick City Md. then and there proceed to take testimony as follows. ~ The Complainants filed with the Commissioners as Evidence, Exhibits A & B. Herewith returned, and then and there, in the presence of the Solicitor for the Complainants, we proceeded to take the following depositions, to wit: ~

Parmenio Marlow, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainants, being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Commissioners by the Complainants and herewith returned, deposes and says. ~

To the 1st Sub. ~ That he is acquainted with the parties to this suit, and has known them for many years. ~

To the 2nd Sub. ~ Daiso Marlow, Draso Marlow, Sarah R. Kelapham, wife of Samuel Kelapham, Thomas J. Marlow, Robert E. Marlow, John S. Marlow and Parmenio Marlow, Margaret E. Marlow, Mary O. Marlow, Frances L. Marlow are all Adults over twenty one years of age; William H. Marlow, Thomas W. Marlow, Clarence Marlow, Edward E. Marlow, Jennette Marlow are all infants under twenty one years. ~

To the 3rd Sub. ~ That he knew Thomas J. Marlow, he is dead. ~

To the 4th Sub. ~ That he knew the real estate of which he died seized and possessed (Exhibits A & B. here handed to witness) he died seized and possessed of, the property described in Exhibits A & B.

To the 5th Sub. ~ That the property is not capable of an advantageous division amongst the parties because it would be cut up into too many small parcels. It would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties, that the property should be sold and the proceeds of the sale divided amongst the parties entitled. ~

To the 6th Sub. ~ That Mary Marlow mentioned in the Bill of Complaint is sixty seven or sixty eight years of age. ~

There being no other witnesses present and no more testimony to be taken, the
