



After my debts, and general expenses are paid. — I give and devise, to my sister Sarah Catharine and Susan Welly, all my right, title claim and interest, of, in and to, the farm, late property of the heirs of Gaspar Welly late of Frederick County Deceased, situated in Frederick County, aforesaid, adjoining the lands of George Develbes David Morrison and others, containing Two Hundred and six acres of land more or less; my interest and quantity of said farm, to them the said Sarah Catharine and Susan Welly, for and during their lives, as a home, and to have and use the profits and issues, of said land, by paying to Jacob Shockey my husband the sum of Eighteen dollars annually, during his life time, in the event of the decease of either of my sisters, then to the two surviving, and finally in the event of the death of the third and last of my sisters it is then to go to my Brother William Welly during his life time, by him paying to the said Jacob Shockey the sum of Eighteen dollars annually, upon the death of my Brother William Welly, then the said interest and land, to go to the heirs ^{or children} of Elias Welly during their lives, by the said heirs of Elias Welly, paying to Jacob Shockey the sum of Eighteen dollars Annually.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute my dearly beloved Brother Elias Welly to be my sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament.

I Jacob Shockey do hereby unreservedly assent to the foregoing Will and Testament of my Wife Elizabeth Shockey.

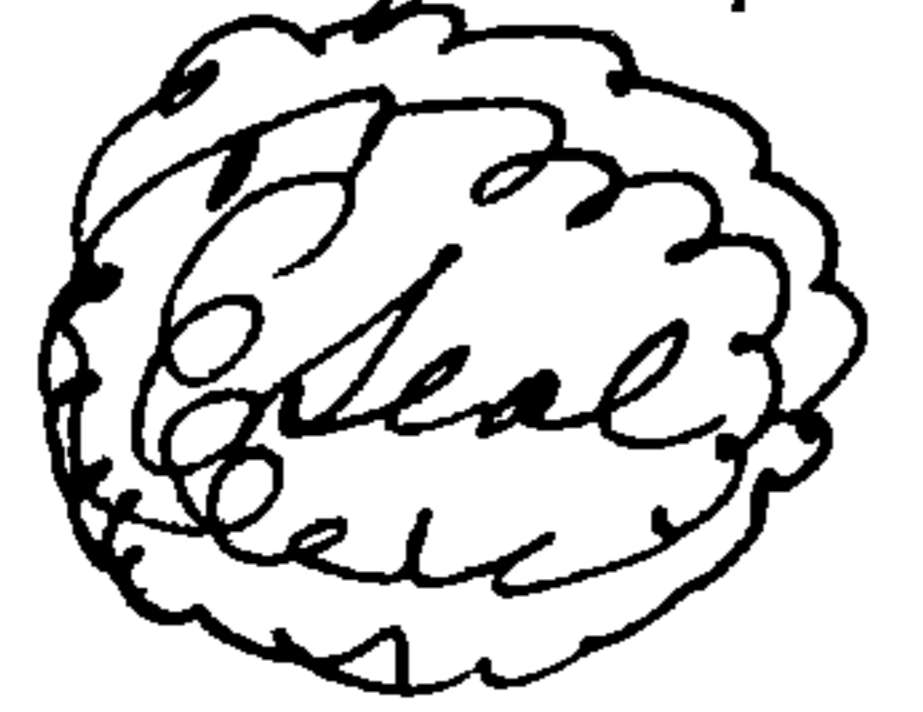
In testimony whereof the said Elizabeth Shockey and Jacob Shockey have hereunto set their hands and seals this 30th day of January 1866.
