To the 5th Sub ~ Witness looks at the copy of the Will of Elizabeth Schockey here shown him, marked Exhibit No. 3 - Elizabeth Schockey is dead, - she died about 2 years ago. - At the time of her death she possessed no real estate but an undivided interest in interest in the real estate specified in Exhibit No. 1. She left Jacob Schockey her husband surviving her. ~ The persons named as devisees in her will, are the same parties named in the title to Complainant's Interrogatories. ~ Elizabeth Schockey left no issue. - Her Brothers and sisters named in this Will were her heirs at law. ~

To the 6th Sub ~ I know the lands described in Exhibits Nos 1 & 2 situated in this County at the Mouth of Tom's Creek in Summitburg district, ~ I do not think said lands could be advantageously divided among the parties according to their interest, because if the lands were divided up into eight parts, it could not be farmed advantageously. ~ I should think it were to the interest of all the parties, that the land should be sold, and the proceeds divided among the parties according to their respective rights. ~

To the 8th Sub: ~ I know nothing else that would be of advantage to the Complainant. ~

The land is poor, and if divided, could not be farmed advantageously by the parties. ~ The fruit is all to one side of the farm; That Deponent thinks the interest of the parties require that said land should be sold, and proceeds of sale distributed among them according to their rights, for the reasons stated above. ~
