On the Third day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred And Sixty Nine; Came the said Joseph W Styler into Court here sitting as a Court of Equity, and filed here by his Solicitor W. The Bill of Complaint of Joseph W Styler of Frederick County State of Maryland in behalf of himself and all other creditors of Francis S. Jones, who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, humbly show to your Honors

That a certain Francis S. Jones, late of Frederick County deceased, was in his lifetime indebted unto your complainant in the sum of Twenty three hundred dollars, on his single Bill dated April 1st Eighteen hundred and sixty seven, payable twelve months after date in the sum of Twenty three hundred dollars with interest thereon, from the date thereof, that the interest on said single Bill up to the twenty fourth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty nine and on the principal of said Note the sum of Three hundred dollars, and the sum of Twelve hundred and fifty dollars has been paid, All of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to said single Bill, herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1. which your complainant brings, together with all other exhibits herein after produced may be taken and considered as part of this his Bill of Complaint, the same as if set forth in words and figures.

Your complainant further Charges, that the said Francis S. Jones died intestate, on the twenty third day of July in the year Eighteen hundred
