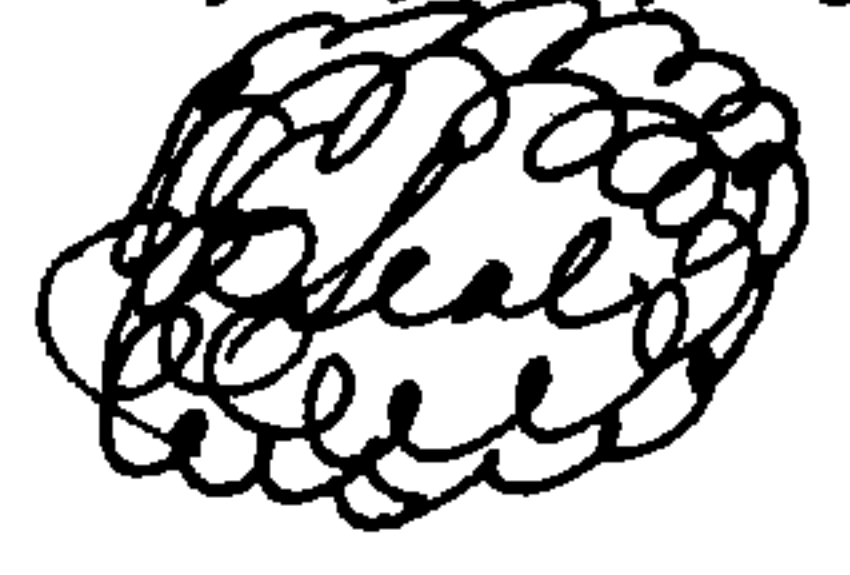

This Deed made this first day of June in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty nine by John Peter Jones and Rachel Le Jones, his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in Consideration of four hundred and twenty nine dollars and eighty four cents the said parties of the first part do grant to Francis S Jones of the County and State aforesaid, the following described parcel of land lying in Mount Pleasant District, and County aforesaid, being part of a piece of land called Colboden, "Beginning at the end of twenty six and seven tenths perches on the seventh line of a deed from Noah Korman and wife, and Sophia Parrick, to John P. Jones recorded in Liber B. No. 10 folio 31 & 32 &c, and running with said line reverse (1st) North 3 1/2 East fifteen and three tenths perches to a stone, (2nd) North four degrees, West thirty eight perches (3rd) North 86 1/2 degrees East thirty two perches, (4th) South thirteen degrees East sixty two and three quarter perches, (5th) South fifty three degrees West twelve perches, (6th) South seventy and a half degrees West Nineteen perches (7th) with a straight line to the beginning, containing seventeen acres and thirty one square perches of land. The aforesaid John P. Jones and wife, also grant unto Francis S Jones or his representatives, provided of a road on the seventh line of the said John P. Jones part of Colboden, to the old Annapolis Road, provided the present road to the said lot should be closed, the road not to be more than twelve feet wide. ~

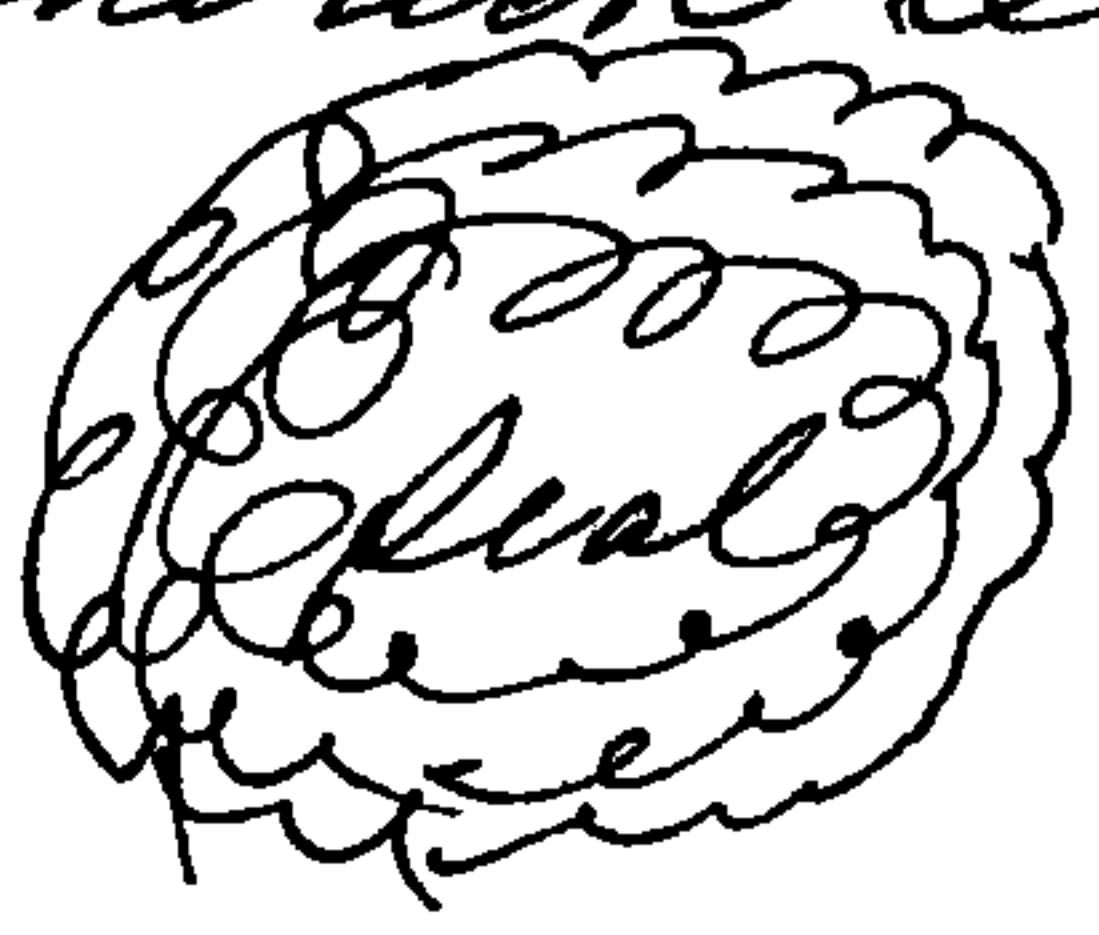
