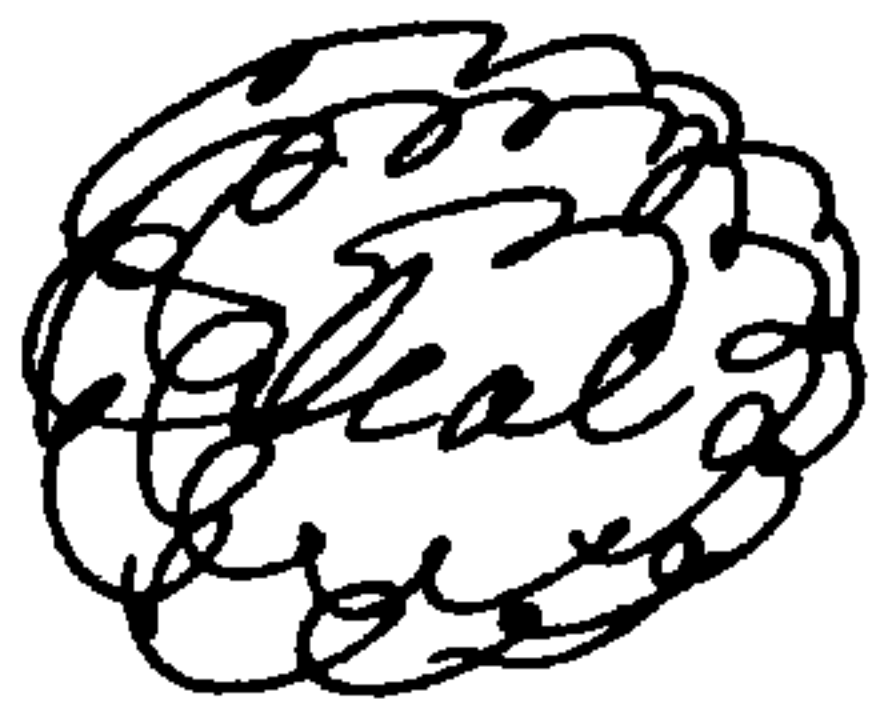

This Deed Made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty nine by Francis S. Jones of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesses, that in consideration of one dollar dollars the said Francis S. Jones does grant to Henry Baker of the County and State aforesaid "such or parcel or strip of land lying in the County aforesaid, and being part of "Dukes Woods" and part of "Howard's Paradise" which was conveyed by the said Henry Baker to the said F. S. Jones and running thence with the lines of said Conveyance reversed, North thirty eight degrees West three fourths of a perch to a stone, South Seventeen and a half degrees West nineteen and Eighty five hundredths perches, South One and thirty five hundredths perches South Eighty six degrees West twelve and one tenth perches to said Bakers tan yard, then North forty five degrees West one and one fourth perches, to the North side of the lane as now shown, and running thence with the fence around to the place of beginning, including a strip of land wide enough for a wagon road connecting said Baker's Tan Yard with his part of "Howard's Paradise". ~
