Whereas Jesse Keiselman of Frederick County State of Maryland, being indebted to sundry parties including the subscribers, in several Sums of Money and being unable to pay the whole of such indebtedness, did assign in conjunction with his wife Elizabeth Keiselman, all his estate and effects, except such property, as is by law exempt from Execution for debt, unto William H. Wagner and George H. Geiselman, and to the survivors of them of said County and State, All his Estate real and personal, in trust for the benefit of his said Creditors, and whereas among other Creditors in said assignment, was one which made the said assignment Ouvre to the benefit of such Creditors of the said Jesse Geiselman as should on or before the fourteenth day of May in the year 1870 agree to accept such dividend or dividends as they might severally obtain under said assignment in full satisfaction of their respective Claims against the said Jesse Geiselman, and sign, seal and deliver to the said Jesse Geiselman a proper and legal release therefor, And whereas the subscribers, Creditors as aforesaid, are desirous to avail themselves of the benefit of said Assignment in trust, upon the Conditions set forth

Therefore for and in Consideration of the Assignment aforesaid, and of the provisions therein made for our benefit, we do hereby release acquit and exonerate and discharge the said Jesse Keiselman from all Claims or demands whatever, which we respectively have or might have against him whether the same be now due or to become due on any existing account whatsoever up to this time, hereby agreeing to look solely to the dividend or dividends that may accrue to us under the assignment aforesaid, in full satisfaction of our respective Claims and demands, Witness our hands and seals this Eleventh day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy.
