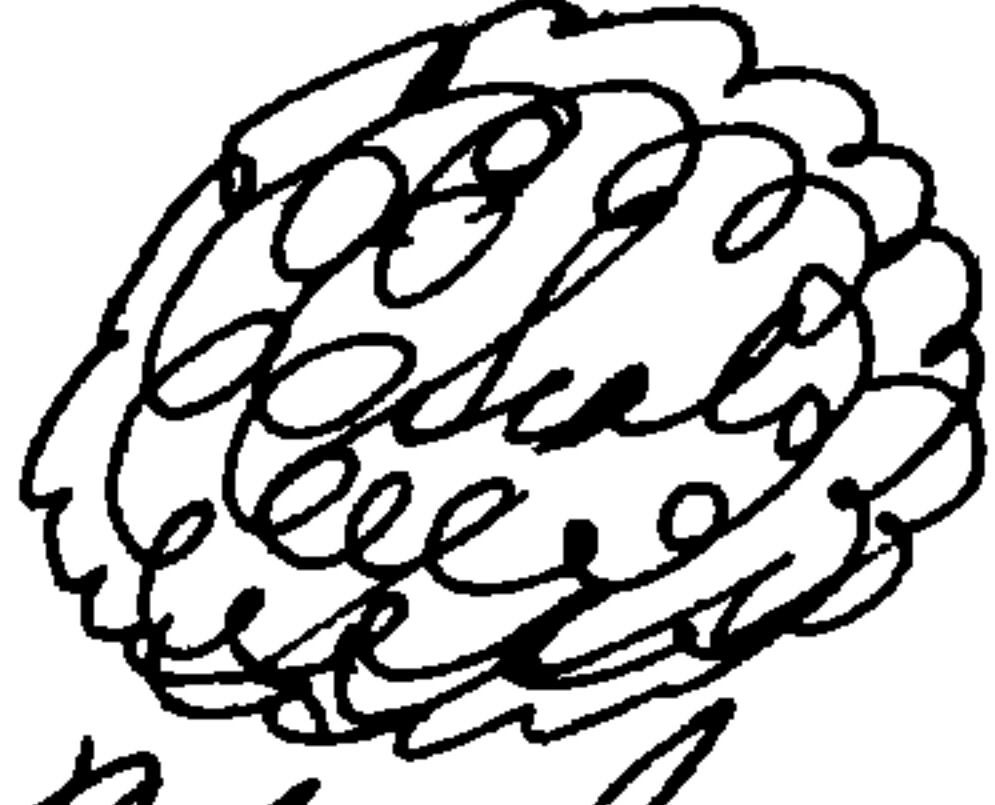

Flook of Clarke County, in the State of Ohio, Titian that in consideration of Eight hundred and Eighty-four dollars, the said Susan R. Flook, hath granted, promised, released, and forever quit claimed, and by these presents doth grant, remise, release and forever quit claim, unto Daniel B. Flook of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, his heirs and assigns forever, All the Dower and Thirds, right and title of Dower and thirds, and all other right, title interest, property, claim and demand whatsoever in Law and Equity of her the said Susan R. Flook, all those pieces, parcels and tracts of land which was conveyed to Jacob C. Flook by Daniel Smeltzer and Jacob Smeltzer, Executors of Henry Smeltzer of Frederick County, deceased, by deed bearing date 25<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year 1854 and recorded in Liber C. S. No. 4 Folios 430 & 431, One of the Land Records of said County as by reference thereto will fully appear; Also all the several pieces, parcels or parts of tracts of land and promises, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid which was conveyed to the said Jacob C. Flook by John Beckenbaugh and Mary Beckenbaugh, his wife, by deed bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year 1856, and recorded in Liber C. S.
