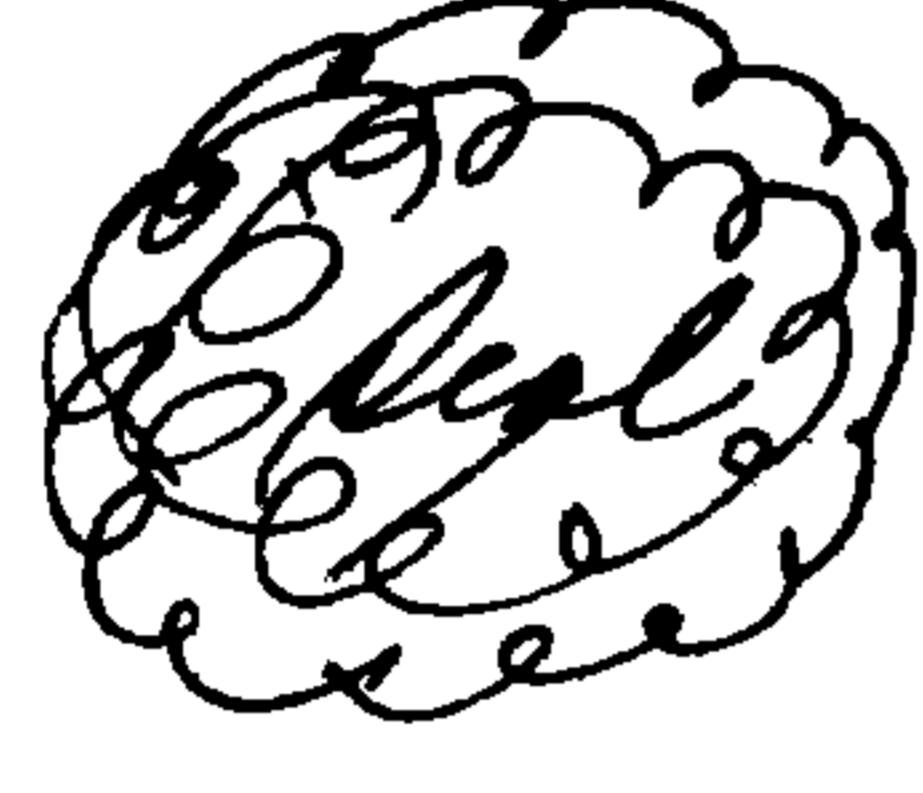

This Deed, made this 10th day of October in the year 1863, by John H. Flook
 Trustee, Notesseth, whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court of Frederick
 County, in the State of Maryland, passed on the 11th day of March in the
 year 1854, the said John H. Flook was appointed Trustee to sell and dispose
 of the Real Estate of Jacob Flook (of John) late of Frederick County deceased
 and has sold the same to Daniel B. Flook, who has fully paid the
 purchase money therefor. ~ Now therefore, in consideration of the sum
 of Three Hundred and seventy six Dollars and Forty seven Cents, the said
 John H. Flook, Trustee, doth grant unto Daniel B. Flook, all the right
 and title of all the parties to the aforesaid Cause, in and to all the several
 following described pieces or parts of tracts of land, situate, lying and being in
 the County aforesaid. The first piece being part of a tract of land,
 situate lying and being in the County aforesaid. ~ The first piece
 being part of a tract of land, called "Ebenezer" - Beginning for said part
 at a stone planted at the end of 18th line of the whole tract called "Ebenezer"
 and running thence S 44° N 13 1/2 ps to a stone standing at the end of the 3rd
 line of "Ebenezer", thence with the outlines of "Ebenezer" the following two
 courses and distances viz. S 60° N 63 1/2 ps to a stone, S 85° N 26 ps to a stone,
 N 1° N 54 1/4 ps to a stone, N 75° E 16 ps to a stone, N. 12° E 18 ps to a stone,
 N 80° E 20 ps to a stone, South 60° E 20 ps. to a stone, S 3° E 19 ps. to a stone
 S 65 1/2° E 14 ps. to a large rock marked No. 8. S 86° E 21 1/2 ps to the place
 of beginning, containing Seventy six Acres and 14 Square ps. of land.
 The second piece or parcel of land being part of a tract of land called
 "The Recovery on Locust Valley", which was conveyed to Jacob Flook
 deceased, by Abraham Snyder, by deed dated March 24th 1819. And
 recorded in Liber S. S. No. 6. folios 270, 271 & 272, one of the Land Records
 of Frederick County. ~ Beginning at the end of the third line in
 the above named deed, and running thence with the 4th line N. 56 1/4
 East 19 ps. N 44 1/2° N 76 ps to the end of three and one fourth perches on
 the 2nd line in said deed, thence with said 2nd line, correcting the course
 S 83° N. 22 ps to a stone, thence with the 3rd line correcting as above S 39 1/4
 E 87 ps to the place of beginning, containing Nine and a half Acres and
