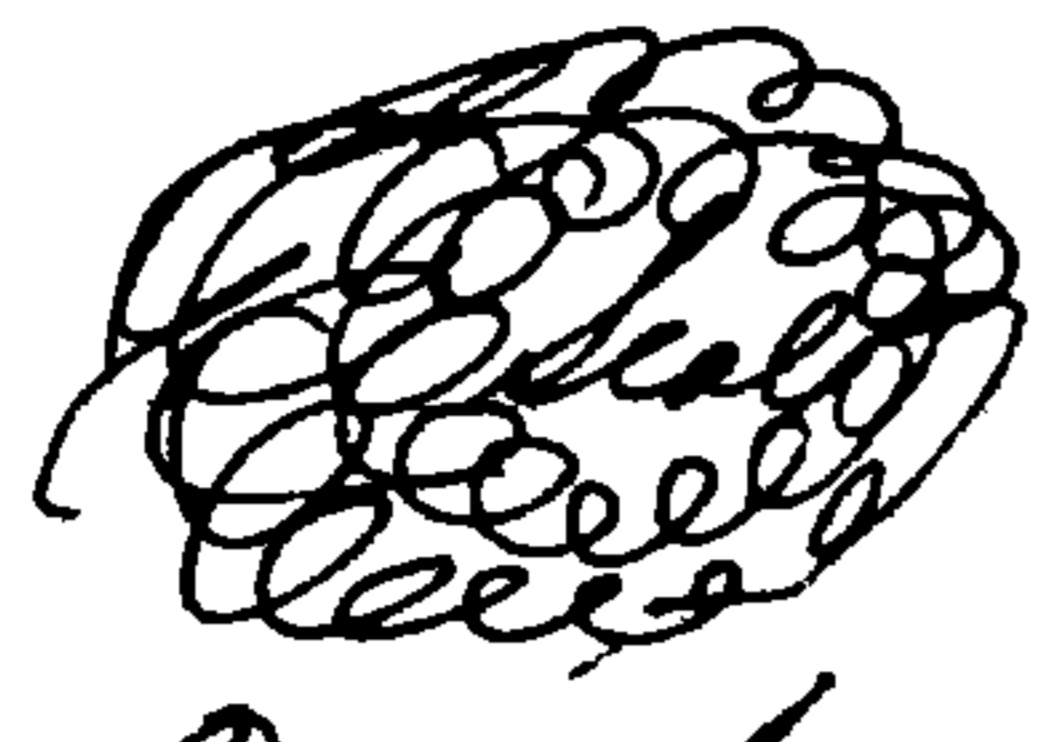

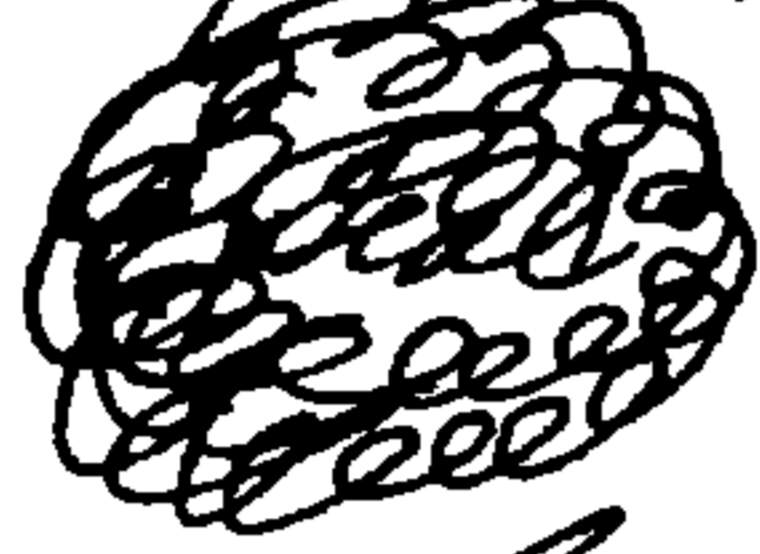

County, Greeting. ~ You are <sup>hereby</sup> commanded that all excuses set apart, you  
personally appear before the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County  
sitting as a Court of Equity, to be held at the Court House in Frederick Town,  
in and for said County, on the third Monday of September next to answer the  
Bill and Complaint of William S. Flook, and Louis M. P. Flook, against  
you in said Court Exhibited, and so forth. ~

Hereof, fail you not, as you will answer, the Contrary at your peril.
