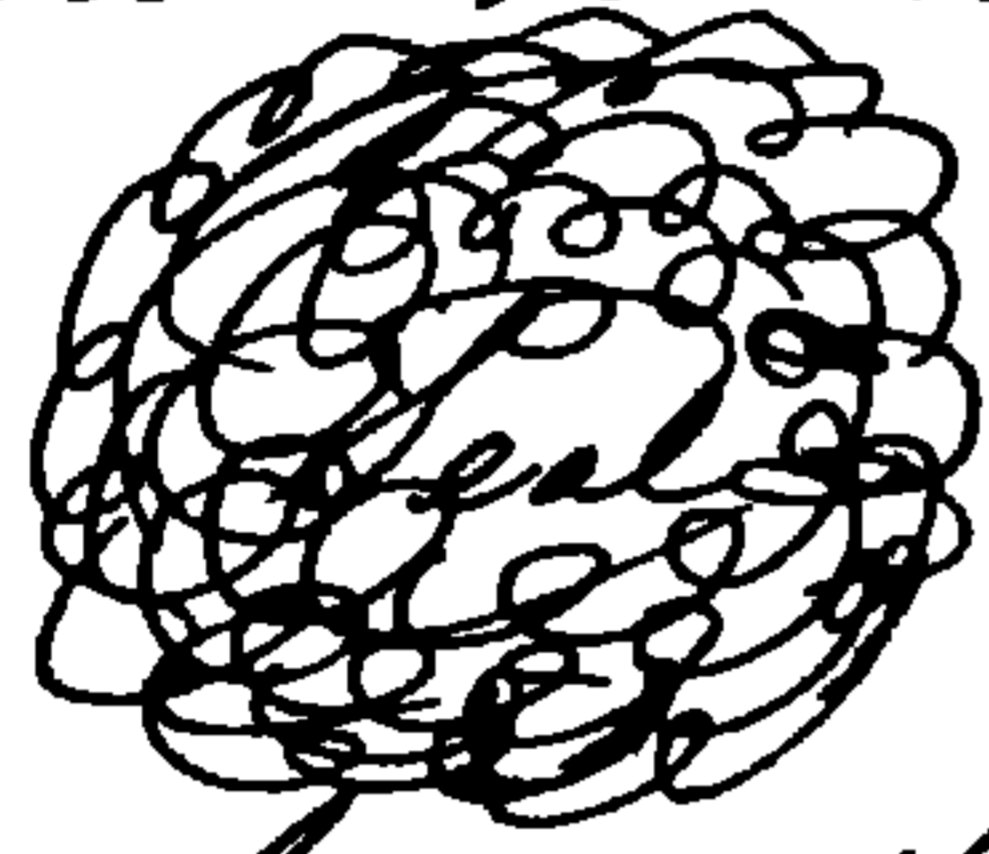

This Deed, made this 20th day of July 1868 by Nathan O. Neighbours, Sheriff of Frederick County Maryland. Witnesseth that by virtue of an execution issued out of the Circuit Court of Frederick County, dated on the twenty seventh day of February 1868, in the case of Jacob Young of D. vs Andrew Draper the said Nathan O. Neighbours Sheriff of Frederick County, has sold to Solomon Forrest at and for the sum of two hundred and seventy five dollars, all the right title interest at law or in Equity of Andrew Draper, of and to the following described property known as part of "Range about the Three Mirable Courts", contained in the following metes and bounds, Courses and distances. Beginning at the end of 3 1/2 perches on the 14th line of the whole tract, and running South 22 1/2° West 118 perches to the first line of "All Meadows" to a stone planted South 71° East 117 perches, North 12 Degrees East 100 perches, North 66 1/2° Degrees East 114 1/4 perches to the first beginning, containing 77 acres more or less. Now therefore the said N. O. Neighbours Sheriff, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and seventy five Dollars to him in hand paid, doth grant, bargain and sell to the said Solomon Forrest all the right and title of Andrew Draper, in and to the hereinbefore described property. ~
