 This Deed made this second day of September in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty seven by John Russard and Susan Russard his wife of Washington County, in the State of Maryland, That in consideration of Two Hundred and fifty dollars, the said John Russard and Susan Russard his wife do grant sell and convey unto Solomon Forrest of Frederick County in the State of Maryland all their right title, claim and interest in that Tract of Land situated in Frederick, being part of a Tract of Land called "The Range" about the "Miserable Kivbs" which is described as follows viz. Beginning at the end of 3rd 1/2 perches on the whole Tract aforesaid, and running thence North 20° West 118 perches to the end of the 5th line of a Tract of Land called Pleasant Level, which is also the end of the first line of a Tract of Land called "All Meadows" and at a stone placed at the end of said line, then South 71° East 117 perches North 12° East 100 perches, then with a straight line to the beginning, containing Seventy seven Acres of Land more or less.

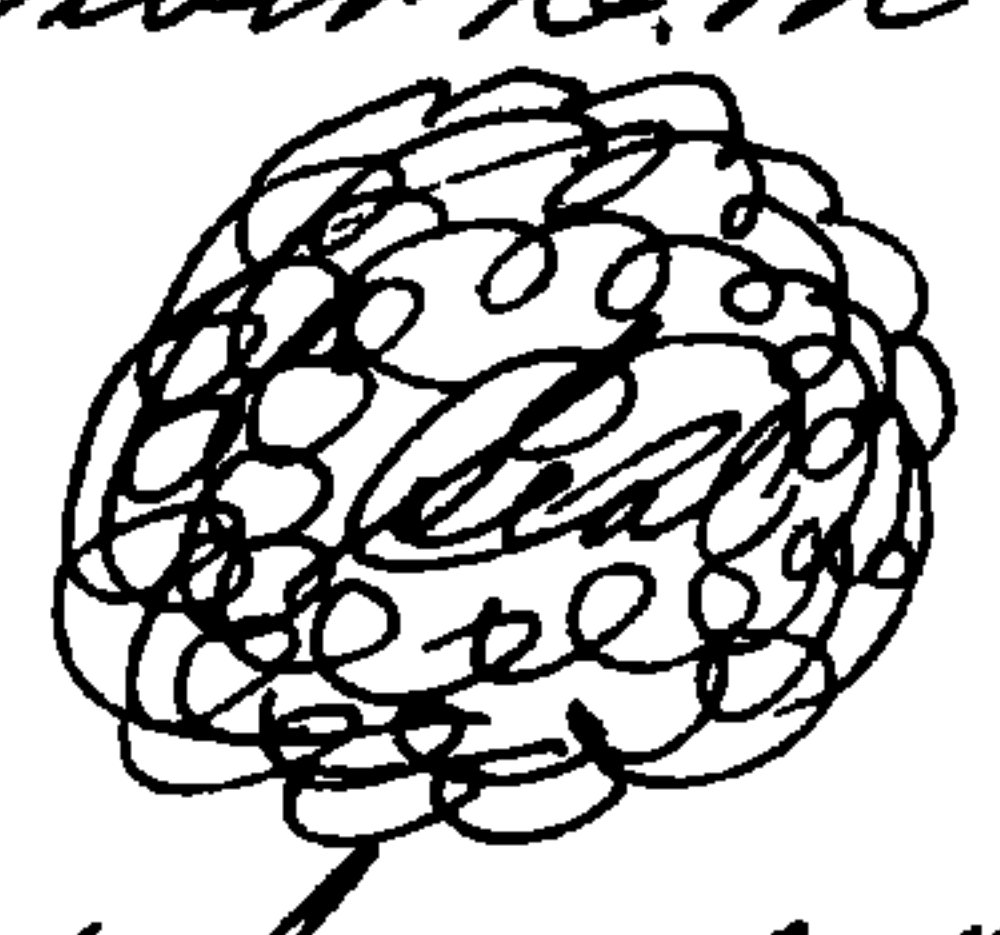

This Indenture, made this 16th day of April, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty One, Between Jonathan Delawter of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Solomon Forrest of the same County State of the other part, Witnesseth That for and in Consideration of the sum of Forty one dollars current money, by the said Solomon Forrest to the said Jonathan Delawter in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid, the said Jonathan Delawter hath bargained and sold, aliened and conveyed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, alien, convey, release, confirm and confirm unto the said Solomon Forrest his heirs and assigns, all that lot or parcel of Land, called "Basket Ridge" lying and being in Frederick County and State aforesaid and heretofore conveyed to said Jonathan Delawter by Thomas Cartlow late Sheriff of Frederick County and State aforesaid, for eight acres more or less by Deed bearing date the 25th day of October Eighteen Hundred and twenty five, and recorded in Liber J.S. No. 23 folios 503, 504, 505, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and Examined &c. Together with all and singular the buildings improvements, ways, waters, water courses, rights, members, privileges, advantages, thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and all that estate right title, interest, truth, property, claim and demand whatsoever at Law and in Equity of him the said Jonathan Delawter, of in and to the same To Have and to Hold the said herein described
