Be it remembered that heretofore, to wit on the 17th day of Nov. 1868 came the said Andrew Heim into Court here sitting as a Court of Equity, by his Attorney John Ritchie Esq and filed here the following Bill with Exhibits therein mentioned

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Andrew Heim of Frederick County and State of Maryland, who sues in his own, and as well in behalf of all other Creditors of Lewis A Heim, late of said County, deceased, who may hereafter come in and become parties to this proceeding, respectfully shows that the said Lewis A. Heim in his life time became indebted to your Complainant in divers sums of money, as follows, to wit, in the principal sum of \$88.50 for a cash balance due on individual loans, which account is herewith filed as Exhibit No 1, and which your Complainant prays may with all other Exhibits herewith produced, be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint, Also in the principal sum of \$571.53, for indebtedness incurred and discharged and moneys advanced by Complainant for said Lewis A Heim in settlement of partnership liabilities of the said Lewis A. Heim; According to the claim herewith filed as Exhibit No. 2, in the further principal sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500-) according to the tenor of a promissory note which is herewith filed as Exhibit No. 3, And also in the further principal sum of five Hundred Dollars (\$500) according to the tenor of another promissory note herewith filed as Exhibit No 4. And all which claims of your Complainant, as set forth in said Exhibits No 1 2 3 & 4, your Complainant charges still to be due owing, and unpaid

And your Complainant further states that the said Lewis A Heim, died at the County aforesaid, on or about the Month of March in the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty seven, seized and possessed of certain Real Estate situate in said County, in Frederick City, consisting of an unimproved lot of land in the West End of said City, on the road leading to Hagerstown, which lot was conveyed to said Lewis A Heim, by deed from Harrieh Lambert and others, and described therein; a certified copy of which deed is herewith filed as Exhibit No. 5; And one other unimproved lot or parcel of land situate near the Bond in West Patrick Street in said City, which lot was conveyed to said Lewis A. Heim by deed from John A Simmons and wife, and described therein, a certified copy of which deed is herewith filed as Exhibit No. 6.

And your Complainant further states, that the said Lewis A. Heim died intestate, and that letters of Administration on his personal Estate, were granted by the Orphan's Court for said County, to Jacob B Heim, now resident in Baltimore City, which will appear by a duly certified copy of said letters of Administration herewith filed as Exhibit No. 7

And your Complainant charges that said Lewis A. Heim in his life time was much indebted by notes, accounts and otherwise, including his indebtedness aforesaid to your Complainant; And further charges that the personal Estate of said Lewis A. Heim is wholly insufficient for the payment of his debts; as will appear by a certified extract by the Register of Wills, from the Inventories and Returns of the personal Estate and effects of said Lewis A. Heim by his said Administrator, and the claims of his creditors proved and docketed in the Orphan's Court for
