Be it remembered that heretofore to wit, On the Third day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Nine, came the said Albert Jones and Wife, and John Dorsey Jones, into Court here sitting as a Court of Equity, by their solicitors Hon<sup>ble</sup> C. Bill

To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Albert Jones and Margaret Ann Jones his wife, and of John Dorsey Jones of Frederick County State of Maryland respectfully shew to your Honors — That a certain Harriett Jones, wife of Francis S Jones of Frederick County State of Maryland, died intestate, seized and possessed of a large and valuable real Estate situate in Frederick County, State aforesaid, being part of a Tract of land called The Resurvey on Drummeine, containing Two Hundred and five and one half Acres of land more or less, and particularly described in a deed from Cordelia M. Downey to said Harriett Jones, a certified copy of which is herewith Exhibited Marked Exhibit No 1, which your Complainants pray, together with all other exhibits herein after produced may be taken and considered as part of this their Bill of Complaint the same as if set forth in words and figures.

Your Complainants further shew to your Honors, that the said Harriett Jones and Francis S Jones, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March in the year Eighteen — and fifty nine, sold and conveyed to a certain Henry Swope by deed dated as aforesaid, seven and one half acres and thirty eight perches of said land, as will appear by a certified copy of said deed herewith Exhibited Marked Exhibit No 2.

Your Complainants further state that the said Harriett Jones died intestate in the month of — in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty — leaving Francis S Jones her husband, her surviving, and the following children her heirs at law to whom the lands aforesaid mentioned, with the exception of that part thereof sold and conveyed in the lifetime of the said Harriett descended — viz. —

2. Albert Jones married to Margaret Ann Poole.
3. John Dorsey Jones a son.
