This Indenture made this 4th day of May One thousand Eight Hundred and fifty nine between George W Janney of the first part and John Le Jordan and John George Jr trading under the firm of Jordan & George of the second part Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars, current money by the said Jordan & George to the said George W Janney in hand paid the receipt where of he doth hereby acknowledge, the said George W Janney doth grant and convey to Jordan and George, all his interest and title in a certain parcel or lot of land lying in the County of Frederick and State of Maryland and heretofore conveyed by John A White to George W. Janney by deed bearing date 9th June 1857, also by Philip Daniel to the same by deed bearing date 25th August 1857, and still another deed made by Order of the Orphan's Court by Joseph M. Conrad dec^d bearing date 11th May 1857 all of which are duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of said County, and contained within the following metes and bounds, to w^{it}: Beginning on the corner of the lands of Hanson Marlow, on the North line of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, thence with said line of the said Canal, ten perches, thence North five and one half degrees East to the Southern line of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road, thence with said line, with said Road five poles to the line of said Marlow, thence with said Marlow's line to the beginning containing three rods and thirty nine perches. ~
