John L. Jordan
vs
Romaine George et al.

No 3591 Equity ~
In the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity

The Bill filed in this cause having charged that Edgar George, and Robert White George, the infant defendants named therein, reside in Loudoun County State of Virginia, and having prayed the Court to appoint two suitable persons residing in said County and State, Commissioners, and authorizing them or either of them to assign a guardian for said infants, and to take the answers of said infants by their guardian, and also to prescribe the mode of authenticating the execution of such Commission. ~

It is therefore this 22nd day of September 1870 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity, ordered that a Commission be issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court, to Samuel W. George, and Samuel George of S. of Loudoun County State of Virginia, authorizing them or either of them to appoint and assign a guardian for Edgar George and Robert White George, the infant defendants named in said Bill, and take the answer of said infants by their said guardian, and that the Execution of said Commission be authenticated in the same manner as Commissions in similar cases are executed in which the answer of infant defendants are taken within this State, under proceedings in Equity. ~

The State of Maryland, To Samuel W. George and Samuel George of S. of Loudoun County Virginia Greeting.

Whereas, John L. Jordan has lately exhibited his Bill of Complaint before me in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, against Romaine George, Edgar George, Robert White George and others. ~

And Whereas I have, by my writ, lately commanded the said Defendants to appear before me in said Court as a Court of Equity, on a certain day now past, to answer the said Bill of Complaint. ~ But for as much as the said Edgar George and Robert White George are infants under age, and cannot answer the said Bill of Complaint nor defend their suit, without having a guardian assigned in their behalf ~ I know Ye, therefore, that I have given unto you or either of you full power and Authority, in pursuance of the special order in said Court, to assign and appoint a guardian for the aforesaid infants, and to take the answer of the said infants, by such guardian to the said Bill of Complaint, and therefore I command you, that at such certain day and place as you shall think fit, you or either of you assign and appoint a guardian for the aforesaid infants, and take the answer of the said infants, by such guardian, to the said Bill of Complaint, on such guardian's Corporal oath upon the Holy Evangelists, to be administered by you or either of you the said answers being distinctly and plainly wrote; And when you shall have taken the said answers, you are to send the same, closed up under your seal, together with your certificate of your having assigned and appointed such guardian as aforesaid, and this writ unto me in said Court. ~
