Snouffer Executor of the Will of Richard Thomas deceased, and against Mary A Thomas, his widow and against Richard Thomas, Ada Thomas, John B Thomas, Frank Thomas, William Thomas, Henry Thomas, Robert Lee Thomas, and Mary J Thomas, defendants, residing in Frederick County, State of Maryland, and against Charles Byron Thomas, the defendant, residing in the City of Baltimore Commanding them and each of them, to be and appear in this Court by a certain day to be named in said Subpoena, to answer the premises and show cause if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed ~ And your Complainant will ever pray &c ~
