Thomas, late of Frederick County did on or about the fourteenth day of March in the year Eighteen Hundred and Fifty Nine, intestate, and seized and possessed of a large and valuable real estate situate in said County and State - Being part of a tract of Land called the "Reservoir on Hazyard" and part of a tract called "Mad wife", containing Two Hundred and Seventeen and One quarter acres of Land, and part of a tract of Land called "Foul Play" containing Twenty three and one half acres of Land, being the land devised to the said Charles E. Thomas by the by the Commissions appointed by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County in the Will of the said Charles E. Thomas, and Otto Thomas ~ Also of all the following tracts or parts of Tracts of Land situate in the County and State aforesaid being part of a tract of Land called "The Reservoir on Hazyard", part of a tract called "Hill in the Middle", and part of a tract called "Dry Branch" containing two hundred and four and one quarter acres of Land - Also Wood Lot No. 2, being part of a tract of Land called "Foul Play" - containing twenty three and one half acres of Land - All of which will appear by a reference to certified Copies of Extracts from the Will of the late Otto Thomas - Petition of Charles E.
