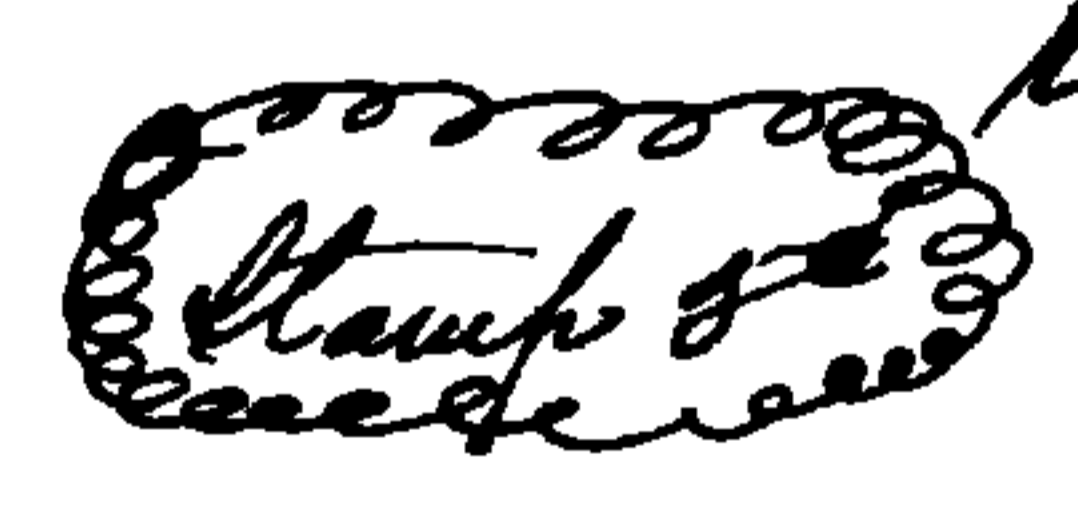
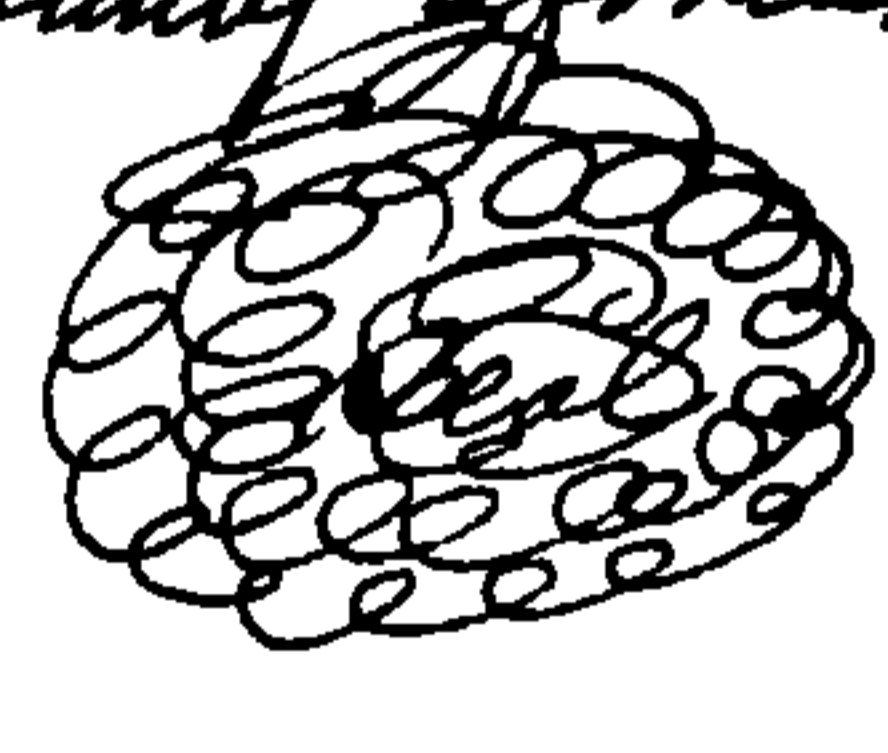

Extracts from the Will of
Otto Thomas dec'd,

I give and devise to Charles E. Thomas, Otto Thomas and Jacob Thomas in fee simple the farms now occupied by myself, Charles E. Thomas, and Robert Raumberg, containing together, seven hundred acres of Land more or less, to be divided in value among them by Commissioners to be appointed by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County, at the instance and on the Petition of my said sons, Charles, Otto and Jacob or any two of them, the Commissioners to make return thereof, and of the Plats and Table of Courses and Distances, Miles and Bounds to the Orphan's Court for Frederick County. ~

I give and devise to my sons Charles E. Thomas, Otto Thomas and Jacob M Thomas the Mountain Lots conveyed to me by John J. Harding, containing Eighty Nine Acres of Land more or less - situated in Frederick County, to be equally divided between them as to value, by Commissioners to be appointed at the request and Petition of my said sons or any two of them - the Commissioners to make return of such division to the Orphan's Court for Frederick County, in the manner hereinbefore provided, by a preceding clause in this my Will. ~
