I Mary Ellen Horsey of Frederick County State of Maryland, do Make, ordain and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, to wit

After my debts and funeral charges are paid, I give devise and bequeath as follows. ~

I give and devise to my Brother Outerbridge Horsey for and during his life, my lands in Frederick County Maryland - And after his death I give and devise such lands to my nephew George Carroll Horsey during his life, and after his death to his oldest son then living in fee simple - And in the event of the said George Carroll Horsey dying without children or grand children then living, I give and bequeath my said lands in Frederick County to my niece Mary Ella Horsey in fee simple, and in the event of my said niece dying before she attains legal age, I give and bequeath my said land in Frederick County to my Niece Eliza Lee Horsey in fee simple. ~

I give and bequeath to my Niece Eliza Lee Mitchell the sum of Two Hundred Dollars per annum in each and every year during her life, and which annuity I charge upon my lands in Frederick County, State of Maryland, and subject them to the payment thereof. ~

I will and bequeath to Maria C. Carroll in trust, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars per annum for four years for the purpose of Aceding in the erection of a Catholic Church in Burkittsville, Frederick County Maryland, this bequest to begin to take effect from the time of my death - If the Church should not be begun to be built during the four years thereafter, then I give and devise the said sum of Five Hundred dollars per annum in trust to the most Reverend Archbishop for the Industrial School of Baltimore Maryland. ~

I give and bequeath to the most Rev. Archbishop in trust, the sum of two hundred dollars per annum for five years, for the Industrial School of Baltimore Maryland. ~

I give and bequeath the sum of One Hundred dollars to my Cousins Sally Thomas Jr. and Maria Thomas or to the survivor of them. ~

I give and bequeath the sum of Fifty dollars to the Novitiate in Frederick Maryland, for Masses. ~

I will and bequeath the following articles to the persons herein named. ~

My gold Chaplain with brooch, gold Cross, and Ornaments attached to Maria C. Carroll and my pearl Cross to Maria C. Carroll. ~

My Cashmere shall to Anna C. Horsey. ~

My diamond and ruby ring to Mary Ella Horsey. ~

My Garnet ring to Eliza Lee Horsey. ~

My Onyx Madonna ring to George Carroll Horsey. ~

My Madonna brooch to Mary Ella Horsey. ~

My black Onyx set to Mrs. M. D. Gouveneur -

My large Florentine Mosaic Brooch to Mrs. E. Leynock

My gold Cross, containing hair of my grand parents to E. C. Horsey. ~

My India Mosaic Box to Anna C. Horsey, the portrait of his grand father Digges to George C. Horsey. ~
