her lifetime was indebted to Complainant? If yes, to what amount? How and
on what account such indebtedness occurred, whether or no, the same be
now due owing and unpaid, and to what time interest was paid thereon?
State fully all your knowledge herein. ~

3rd Interrogatory. ~ Did you or not know Mary Ellen Horsey, daughter
of the late Mrs. Eliza D. Horsey? If yes, is she living, or dead? If dead,
when and where did she die?

4th Interrogatory ~ You say, Mary Ellen Horsey is dead, did she die
testate or intestate? Did she leave real estate? If yes, where situated? How
did she acquire title, and describe fully such real estate, state fully all
your knowledge herein. ~

5th Interrogatory ~ Special to Outerbridge Horsey Executor. ~

Are you the Executor of the will of Mary Ellen Horsey? If yes, have
you filed your bond as Executor, and entered upon the duties of your Office?

6th Interrogatory ~ Special to Outerbridge Horsey Executor. ~
