To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County Sitting in Equity:

The Report of John Ritchie, Receiver, appointed by the Decree in this Cause, bearing date on the 29th day of November in the year 1869, respectfully shows, that on said 29th day of November 1869, he gave bond with security, which was duly approved, for the faithful discharge of his trust as said Receiver as prescribed by said Decree. And further shows that in pursuance of the Order of the Court passed in said Cause, on the 21st day of December in the year 1869, he proceeded to wind up the affairs of the dissolved Partnership of said Griffiths and Mason in the mode prescribed by said decree or order as follows. -

Said Receiver, as directed by said Order, gave notice for three consecutive weeks prior to the 1st day of March A.D. 1870 in the "Union" a Newspaper published in Frederick City, to the Creditors of Griffiths and Mason, to file their Claims, properly authenticated, with the Clerk of said Court, on or before the first day of March A.D. 1870, otherwise they might be debarred from the benefit of participation in the funds of said Partnership; As will appear by reference to the Printer's Certificate of said publication herewith filed as part of this Report as Exhibit No 1. -

That he did proceed as directed by said Order, to collect the debts due said Partnership, and had collected from the following debtors the following sums on open Account, viz:
