

This Indenture made this 11th day of February, in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty one, between John Adam Staley and Ann R. his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland of the One part and Susanna C. Staley, Simon M. Staley, Renee Staley, Charles W. Staley and Daniel Staley, of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said John Adam Staley and Ann Rebecca Staley his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, Current money, of the United States to them in hand paid by the said, Susanna C. Staley, Simon M. Staley, Renee R. Staley, Charles W. Staley and Daniel Adam Staley, before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof, they, the said John Adam Staley, and Ann Rebecca his wife doth hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, infeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, infeoff and confirm unto the said, Susanna Staley, Simon M. Staley, Renee R. Staley, Charles W. Staley, and Daniel Adam Staley, their heirs and assigns, all that part, piece or parcel of land called "Puzzlesome corrected" and all that part of a tract of Land called "Mill Haven" heretofore conveyed to the one Henry Staley by him the said John Adam Staley by deed bearing date the 28th day of May 1834, recorded in Liber J. S. No 45 folios 79 80 & 81, recorded in one of the Land Records of Frederick County, as by reference to said deed for courses and distances will fully and at large appear, together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, and appurtenances, whatsoever, thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining, to them, the said Susanna C. Staley, Simon M. Staley, Renee R. Staley, Charles W. Staley and Daniel Adam Staley, their heirs and assigns forever Intention whereof the said John Adam Staley and Ann Rebecca Staley his wife hath hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals the day and year first hereun before written. ~
