

The State of Maryland, To Francis Brungle and John S. R. Hood Esqrs of Frederick County, Greeting. ~

Be it Known, That you are appointed Commissioners, to examine Evidence in a cause depending in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity, between Charles H. Staley and others, Complainants, and Mark Le Carpenter and others Defendants.
