To the 1st Sub: That he knows all of the parties to this suit, except Eliza A. Dixon, and has known them for some years.

To the 2nd Sub: That he knows the handwritings of Benjamin S. Dixon and Hugh McAlister; has frequently seen them both write, that he looks at Exhibits Nos 2 & 3 now here shown him, and that the signatures "B. S. Dixon" "B. S. Dixon" attached to Exhibits Nos. 2 & 3 are in the proper hand writing of Benjamin S. Dixon, that the assignments are in the proper handwriting of Hugh McAlister. -

To the 3rd Sub: That he looks at Exhibit No 1, now here shown him; that Benjamin S. Dixon is now in possession of the property therein described; that the Mortgage is owned by Henry Loreutz, deponent, and the notes (Exhibits Nos 2 & 3) are owned by Mary Le. Shriner; that no part has been paid, and that there is owing to Henry Loreutz the sum of Twenty three hundred and thirty two dollars, with interest from the first day of April A.D. 1870, the amount of the two notes now held by said Deponent. -

To the 4th Sub: That he knows nothing. -

To the 5th Sub: That he knows nothing further than he has already stated in his answers to the foregoing interrogatories. -

Edward A. Shriner, a witness of lawful age, produced upon the part of the Complainant being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Commissioners by the Complainant and herewith returned, deposes & says.

To the 1st Sub: That he is acquainted with all of the parties to this suit and has known them for some years;

To the 2nd Sub: That he knows the handwritings of Benjamin S. Dixon and Hugh McAlister; has frequently seen them write, that the signatures "B. S. Dixon" attached to Exhibits Nos. 2 & 3 are in the proper hand writing of said Benjamin S. Dixon, and that the assignments endorsed on said Exhibits are in the proper hand writing of Hugh McAlister. -

To the 3rd Sub: That he knows nothing. -

To the 4th Sub: That he looks at Exhibit No 4 "now here shown him; that Mary Le. Shriner is owner of said Mortgage; and of the two notes (Exhibits Nos. 2 & 3) that there is due on each of said two notes the sum of Eight hundred and nine dollars and forty four cents (\$809.⁴⁴/₁₀₀) with interest on one from the first day of October A.D. 1870, and on the other from the first day of April A.D. 1871, and that no payments have been made on either of the said two notes, either principal or interest.

To the 5th Sub: That he knows nothing further. -

There being no other witnesses present to be examined, and no further time being required for the production of evidences, the Commissioners closed said Commission, and herewith return the same under their hands and seals this 21st day of October A.D. 1871. -
