

as a Complainant, and Daniel Willhide and others, Respondents, and which Commission is hereto annexed, that after having given notice as required, to the parties interested, of the time and place of our Meeting, we did, in pursuance of said notice, having first taken the oath annexed to said Commission, meet on the land mentioned in said Commission on the fifth day of February Eighteen Hundred and forty two, and did walk over said land, and caused the same to be surveyed and divided into two equal parts as directed by said Commission, by Leonard Pickney a Surveyor who was appointed by us in manner and form following, to wit:

Beginning for the outlines of the tract Called "Weaver's Weave Stool" at a stone planted two perches from a branch that runs into Hunting Creek, on the East side thereof, now on a public road. And running thence, South Eighty three degrees, East forty perches to a stone planted, South Sixty one degrees, East Sixty eight perches to a stone planted, North fifty six degrees East One Hundred and twenty perches to a stone planted, North fifty six degrees East One Hundred and twenty perches to a stone planted, North fifty degrees West One Hundred and forty perches to a stone planted, thence leaving the aforesaid Tract and running seven Courses with a Tract called "Bruckers Patch" viz: South Sixty degrees West Twelve perches to a stone, North One degree East fifty two perches, South Sixty five degrees West fifty two and a half perches, South twenty six degrees East forty eight and a half perches to a stone planted, South sixty four degrees West forty nine perches to a stone planted in the aforesaid road, thence with it South four degrees East Eighteen and a half perches, South thirteen and a half degrees West seven perches, to a stone planted, South Twelve degrees West fifty two perches to the Beginning, — And beginning for the divisional line of the two tracts hereby laid off, at the end of five and three tenths perches on the sixth and last line of the Tract Called "Weaver's Weave Stool" conveyed by Jacob Willhide and John Shuff to Conrad Willhide, thence with a straight line to the end of eighty four perches on the fourth line of the Tract called Weaver's Weave Stool aforesaid.

Thereby dividing the whole tract into two Lots or parcels of land designated as Lot No. 1, and Lot No. 2. — And Beginning for Lot No. 1. at the end of five and three tenths perches on the last line of the whole Tract, and running thence South twelve degrees West forty six and seven tenths perches, South Eighty three degrees, East forty perches, South Sixty one degrees East Sixty eight perches, North fifty six degrees East One Hundred and twenty perches, North fifty degrees West Eighty four perches, thence with a straight line to the beginning, And be beginning for Lot No. 2, at the end of Eighty four perches on the fourth line of the tract called Weaver's Weave Stool, and running with said fourth line North fifty degrees West fifty six perches, South Sixty degrees West Twelve perches to a stone planted, North One degree East fifty two perches, South Sixty five degrees West fifty two and a half perches to a stone planted, South sixty four degrees West forty nine perches, to a stone planted in the public road, thence with it South four degrees East Eighteen and a half perches, South thirteen and a half degrees West seven perches, thence South twelve degrees West five and three tenths perches, then with a straight line to the Beginning.

And we do hereby assign, allot, and lay off the said Lot No. 2 as the part of portion of William Willhide, containing thirty seven and a half Acres of land, and as the portion Daniel Willhide, John W. Willhide, Conrad Willhide, Caroline Willhide Jane Willhide, Simon Willhide, and Sarah Ann Willhide, Lot No. 1. — All which proceedings, together with a plat of said land, and of the division thereof, and the aforesaid Commission we return close under our hands & seals the fifth day of February 1842. —
