The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of the Real Estate wherof Joseph Ouelman late of Frederick County, died seized and possessed, and the distribution of the proceeds amongst the parties entitled to the same, in proportion to their several interests. ~

The Bill states that said Joseph Ouelman, some time in the Month of in the year 1840, died seized of a certain House and Lot of Land in Emmettsburg in Frederick County Maryland and leaving the Complainants Elizabeth Loy, Levi Ouelman, William Ouelman, David Ouelman, John Ouelman, Mary le Ouelman and Hannah Ouelman, and the Defendant Elizabeth Ouelman his heirs at law, who are seized and possessed of said Real Estate as tenants in Common. The said real estate is not susceptible of division without great loss, and that it would be to the advantage of all the parties interested that said real estate be sold, and the proceeds divided amongst the parties entitled, in proportion to their several interests. ~

And the Bill further states, that the Defendant Elizabeth Ouelman is now Complainant and resides out of the State of Maryland. ~

It is therefore adjudged and ordered that the Complainants by causing a copy of this Order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick town once in each of four successive weeks before the 5th day of September next, give notice to the said absent Defendant of the object and substance of this Bill, and warn her to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 2nd day of December next to answer these premises, and shew cause if any she have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed. ~
