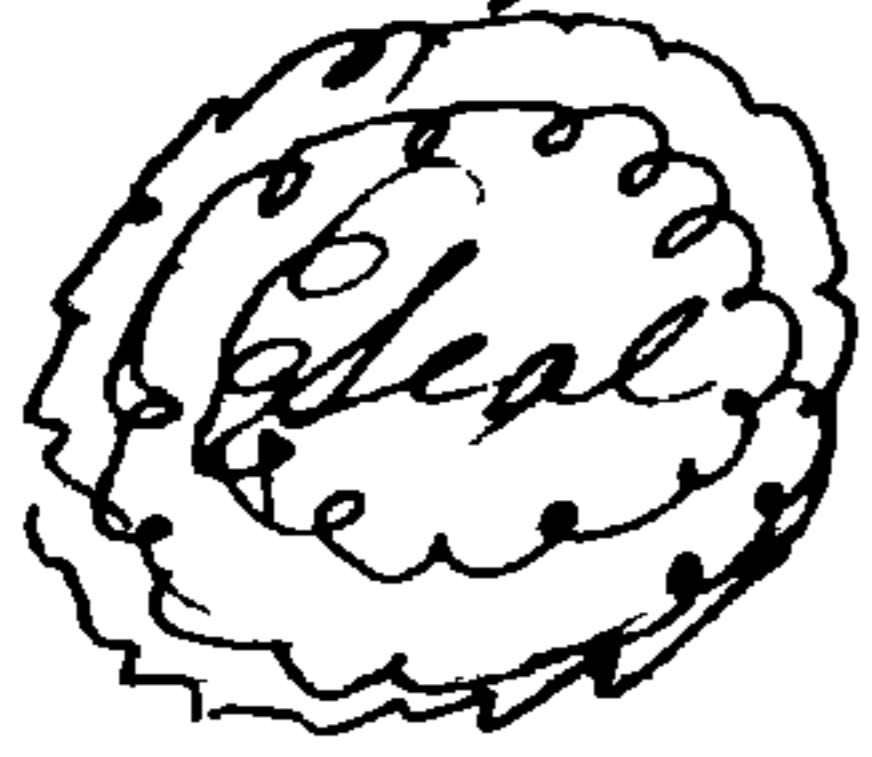

Eighteen Hundred and fifty seven, Letters of Administration of all and singular
the goods chattels and credits what whereof John G Chapman late of Charles County
deceased, was by the Orphan's Court of Charles County aforesaid, granted and com-
mitted unto John G Chapman and Marshall Chapman of the said County and
State, they having first entered into Bond with approved security, for the
faithful performance of the duties thereof.

1857.
