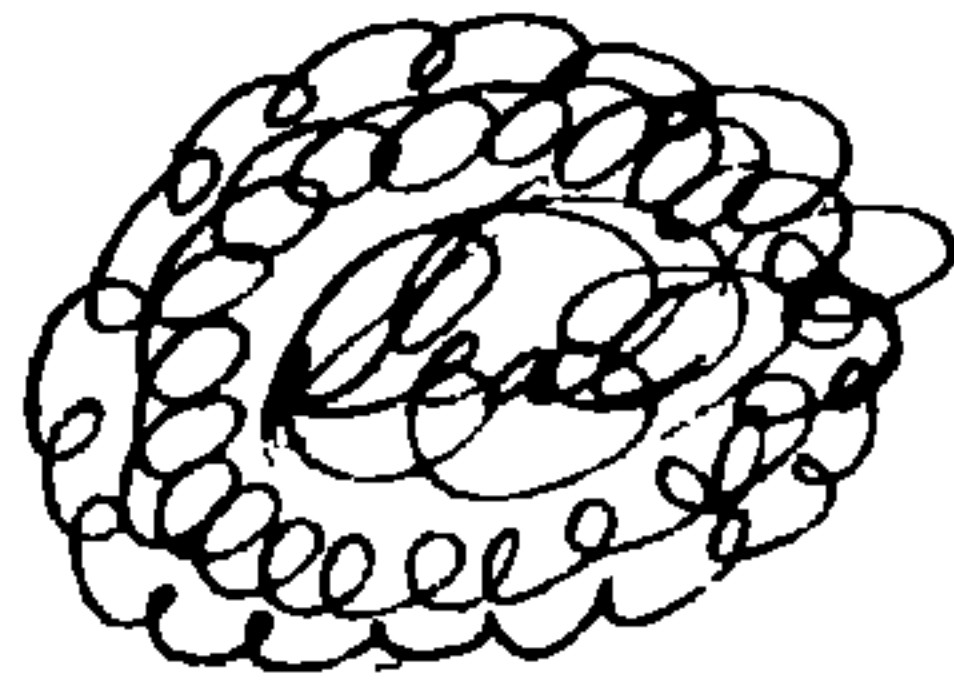

V The President and Treasurer shall execute said Bonds in Blank to such amount, as shall from time to time be specially directed by the Board, and the same shall be placed in the hands of the Treasurer, the President and Treasurer keeping an account of the Numbers and amounts of said Bonds. Whenever a loan shall be negotiated, The Treasurer shall deliver said Bonds to the Secretary, who shall forthwith fill up the blanks with the name of the lender and the date, which shall be the day when said Bonds are delivered to him; he shall also countersign, affix the Corporate seal, and redeliver the same to the Treasurer, who shall thereupon inform the President stating the name of lender, the date and number of the bond, and the amount loaned, and the terms

VI - The President, Treasurer and Secretary, shall each keep a Register in which shall be entered the number, date, amount and name of the lender in each bond issued. The Secretary shall not countersign nor seal any bond until all the blanks therein shall have been filled; - Nor to a greater amount than may be from time to time directed by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall be responsible for the amount of all Bonds delivered to him in Blank or otherwise, and shall be discharged his responsibility only upon delivering up said bonds or accounting for the proceeds thereof.
